(Outcome); What does the student need to know in order to do this well? (Curriculum); What activity will facilitate the learning? (Pedagogy); How will the student demonstrate the learning? (Assessment); How will I know the student has done this well? (Criteria). Dr Jagdish Godihal highlighted upon Why we need to give more emphasis on setting qualitative and thought provoking question papers based on OBE philosophy using blooms taxonomy It bulds evidence for accountability, accreditation and improvement. It shows evidence of how well our students learn and Uses evidence for continuous improvement.

About the FDP on Outcome-Based Education:

5 - Day Faculty Development Programme was organized on Outcome-based Education from 12th to 18th August, 2022 in the Auditorium, Presidency University. The objective of this faculty development programme is to nurture the philosophy of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) and build the capacity and competencies of the faculty members in the teaching-learning system and other Academic Process of the University. The development and implementation of good academic processes in an institutionalized manner by involving all stakeholders for continuous improvement are paramount in assuring the quality of the programmes.

The FDP was conducted with sufficient discussions, deliberations in a case study approach, and provides a hands-on experience on re-engineering or fine-tuning the academic processes that improves the quality of the outcome education. Highly renowned professionals from academia and industry were invited to enlighten the participants on various areas.

OBE Day 1: 12th August, 2022

The 5-day Faculty Development Program on Outcome Based Education commenced on August 12th, at 9:30am, with an inaugural ceremony in the presence of Mr. Ajay Bhagwat, Director, Inpods (Resource Person), Dr. AM Surendrakumar, Pro-Vice Chancellor (Academics), Dr. Muddu Vinay, Pro-Vice Chancellor (Management), Dr. NT Rao, Pro-Vice Chancellor (Engineering), Dr. Shilpa Mehta, Dean Academics, Dr. Beeran Moidin, Registrar and other dignitaries. The dignitaries officially inaugurated the FDP with lighting of the lamp. The welcome address was given by the Program coordinator Dr. SR Sudheendra, Dy. COE, Presidency University.

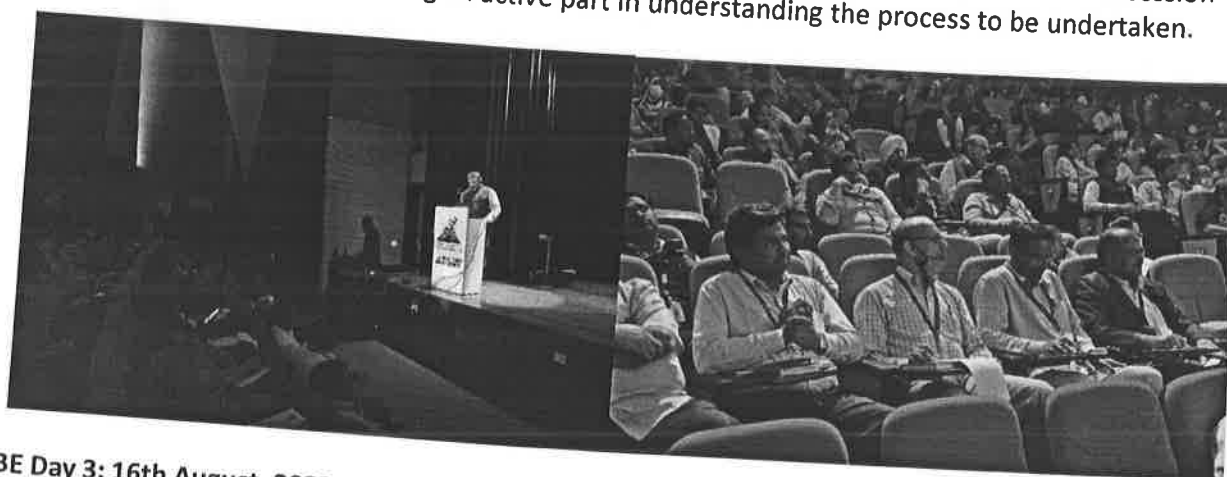

OBE Day 2: 13th August, 2022

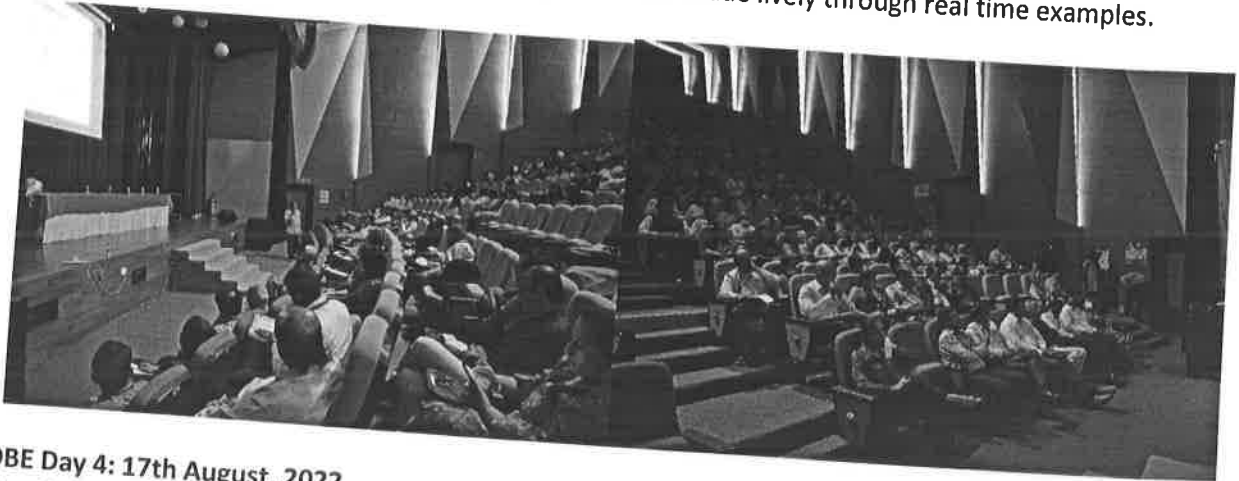
In continuation of first day, the resource person Mr. Ajay Bhagwat, Director, Inpods has explained about Questions Design to Measure COs, CO-PO Attainment Computation and Outcomes Analysis, Use of Technology for CO-PO Attainment Computation and Outcomes Analysis and Improving Employability Outcomes. The process of designing the curriculum to obtaining the appropriate outcome based education was discussed in detail with the active participation of the participants. The secession was interactive with the audience taking an active part in understanding the process to be undertaken.



OBE Day 3: 16th August, 2022

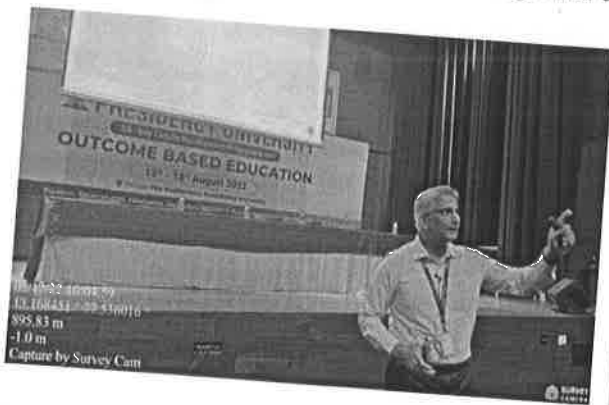
The day 3 sessions was taken by Dr. S. Baskar, BOYSCAT Fellow, Dean (R &D), Thiagarajar College of Engineering, Madurai and OBE Specialist on Introduction to Outcome Based Education, Key parameters of OBE, Vision, Mission and PEO's/GA/POs/PSOs, Revised Blooms Taxonomy in Cognitive domain and Articulation of COs, CO-PO mapping, Role of Blooms Taxonomy in Teaching and Learning. The speaker gave presentation on the process and the basis for the framing of the course outcomes for the different subjects. A neat and detailed presentation was also explained to the participants on the mapping process of the course outcomes and program outcomes. The speaker also gave a presentation on the

process of attainment of program outcome and program specific outcomes and the method of calculating the PEOs, GA, POs and PSO's were neatly explained. Work sheets were also given for calculating the same which the participants were able to take part in. Detailed explanations were given by the speaker to all the queries made by the participants. Active physical participation was also given to the participants for understanding the rubrics for OBE. The interaction was lively with audience interacting with the speaker and the day 3 sessions was made lively through real time examples.

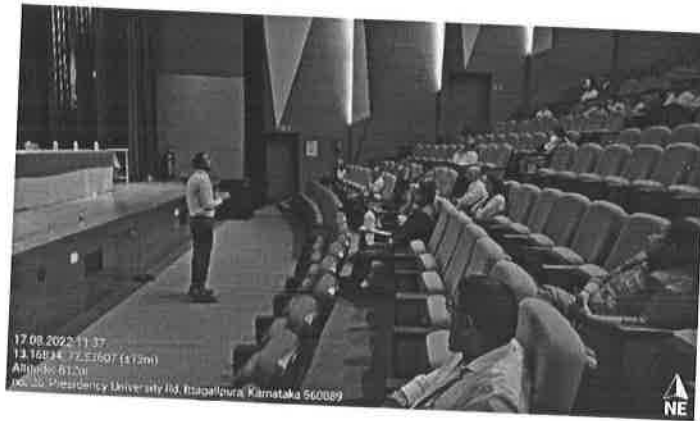


OBE Day 4: 17th August, 2022

The first speaker of the fourth day was Dr. Krishnakumar K- Professor & Associate Dean, SoM, Presidency University. He has spoken about Pedagogy and Content Delivery. He has explained the Different pedagogical theories have informed the evolution of both traditional and online education. Technology has made possible the emergence of a new pedagogy that opens up learning and makes it more accessible and flexible. It is also a pedagogy that increases the sharing power between the instructor and the learner. He also explained the role of the instructor is now trending toward a focus on developing and supporting learner autonomy, including negotiating with learners over the selection and organization of content and methods. He emphasized the paradigm shift in focus of pedagogy towards student learning rather than mere teaching by faculty. Learning outcomes need to be defined for every course conducted by the university right at the outset so that they serve as a template for further downstream processes of curriculum design and drafting of teaching plan by faculty.



The second speaker of the fourth day was Dr. Sivaperumal S, Dean -Sponsored Research, Presidency University. He has spoken about Project Based Learning and Higher Order Thinking. He has explained how Project-based learning can be more engaging for students than a lecture and make it easier for educators to demonstrate how a topic, in any subject, is applied in the real world. Project-based learning, however, can bring benefits in addition to the deeper learning and engagement students enjoy. It will help to foster self-regulation and self-management, skills that can equip students for better success in the real-world. He also spoken about the job opportunities and higher education in foreign universities.



The third speaker of the fourth day was Dr. B V Prabhu, Asso. Director-Career Services and Industry Connect, Presidency University. He has spoken about Industry Academia Interface. He has spoken about the aim of Industry Academia Interface is to make our university a Centre of Excellence for Research, Training & Consultancy. The collaboration is beneficial for Industry as well as the Institute with the shared human resource, Infrastructure, lab setup, equipment & facilities. The Industry can take help of Institute for carrying out R&D and to solve any technical hurdles, and on the other hand the students & faculties get a chance to further hone their skills & knowledge in the Industry environment by taking up internship opportunities & related projects. He has explained how facilitate Institute & Industry engagement through internships, joint projects with industry, seminars, workshops, Industrial visits, student exchange programs and placements.

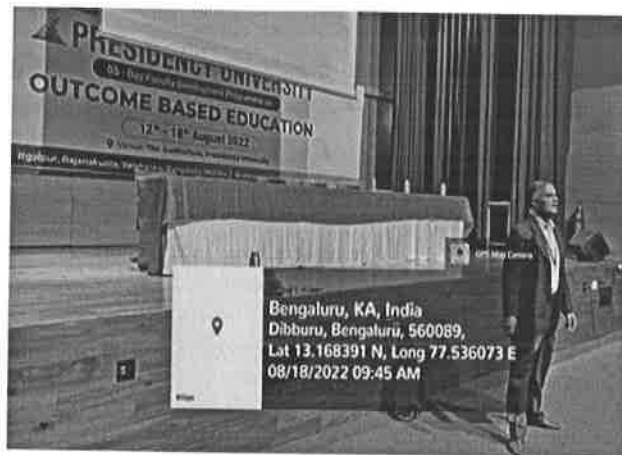


The fourth speaker of the fourth day was Dr. C S Ramesh, Dean (Research & Development), Presidency University. He has spoken about Innovation in Education. Dr. Ramesh started with general discussion about why Education is seen as central in fostering creative and innovative skills. He has highlighted that creativity in education has more to do with the process than with the product, and focus is therefore on the development of thinking and cognitive skills. He opined that the teachers should leverage the upsurge of new media and technologies that students use in their everyday lives that can further be exploited in creative and innovative ways. Teachers need to develop creative approaches and find new methods, solutions and practices to grab the attention of the students. He focused on the use of methods/games to explain the practical application of the concepts stating that it is need of the hour. He also indicated the paramount role of training the students with respect to reviewing research, writing research proposals, documenting project discussions held with mentor, to increase their employability and credibility and focused on inclusion of case studies and practical aspects when teaching in the classroom.



OBE Day 5: 18th August, 2022

The first speaker of the final day of the FDP was Dr. Jagdish H Godihal -Prof.-CIV & Deputy Dean - Academic Research, Presidency University. He has spoken about OBE, Blooms Taxonomy and Question Papers. He had given a framework to Designing Courses based on Learning Outcomes, like What do you want the student to be able to do? (Outcome); What does the student need to know in order to do this well? (Curriculum); What activity will facilitate the learning? (Pedagogy); How will the student demonstrate the learning? (Assessment); How will I know the student has done this well? (Criteria). Dr Jagdish Godihal highlighted upon Why we need to give more emphasis on setting qualitative and thought provoking question papers based on OBE philosophy using blooms taxonomy It builds evidence for accountability, accreditation and improvement. It shows evidence of how well our students learn and Uses evidence for continuous improvement.



The second speaker of the final day of the FDP was Dr. AM Surendrakumar, Pro-Vice Chancellor, Presidency University. He has spoken about Outcome Based Question Papers and Quality Measurement. He has explained the key aspect of Outcome-Based Education is an assessment of learning outcomes. OBE assessment of the outcomes of the course is the most critical feature required to improve the quality of education. Learning outcomes are concrete, formal statements that state what students are expected to learn in a course. Program Outcomes are the knowledge, skills, and attitudes that students should have at the end of the course. POs can be measured through Course Outcomes which broad statements are indicating knowledge, skills acquired at the end of the course. The results of each course are based on COs and POs. An innovative method is needed for assessing the COs and POs. He has also explained the methodology by using the students' performance in internal assessment, end exam, assignments, and course exit feedback; calculate the attainment of the course. The OBE assists in the creation of effective lesson plans, high-quality question papers, and effective rubrics for course

evaluation. The outcome-based approach necessitates a paradigm shift in the curriculum process and how the learner is empowered to achieve outcomes.



The FDP quiz has been conducted online with MS Team Link to fulfill the objective of the FDP.

The Valedictory function was held at Auditorium, Presidency University on 18th August 2022 from 04:00 PM to 04:30 PM. The program was presided over by the program coordinator Dr. SR Sudheendra, Dy. COE, Presidency University. The valedictory function was also attended by Dr. AM Surendrakumar, Pro-Vice Chancellor, Presidency University, Dr. Shilpa Mehta, Dean Academics, Deans/HoDs. Among others who attended the Valedictory function were the distinguished resource persons, faculty members of Presidency University and invitees. The welcome and overview of the 5 day Faculty development program was given by the program coordinator, Dr. SR Sudheendra. 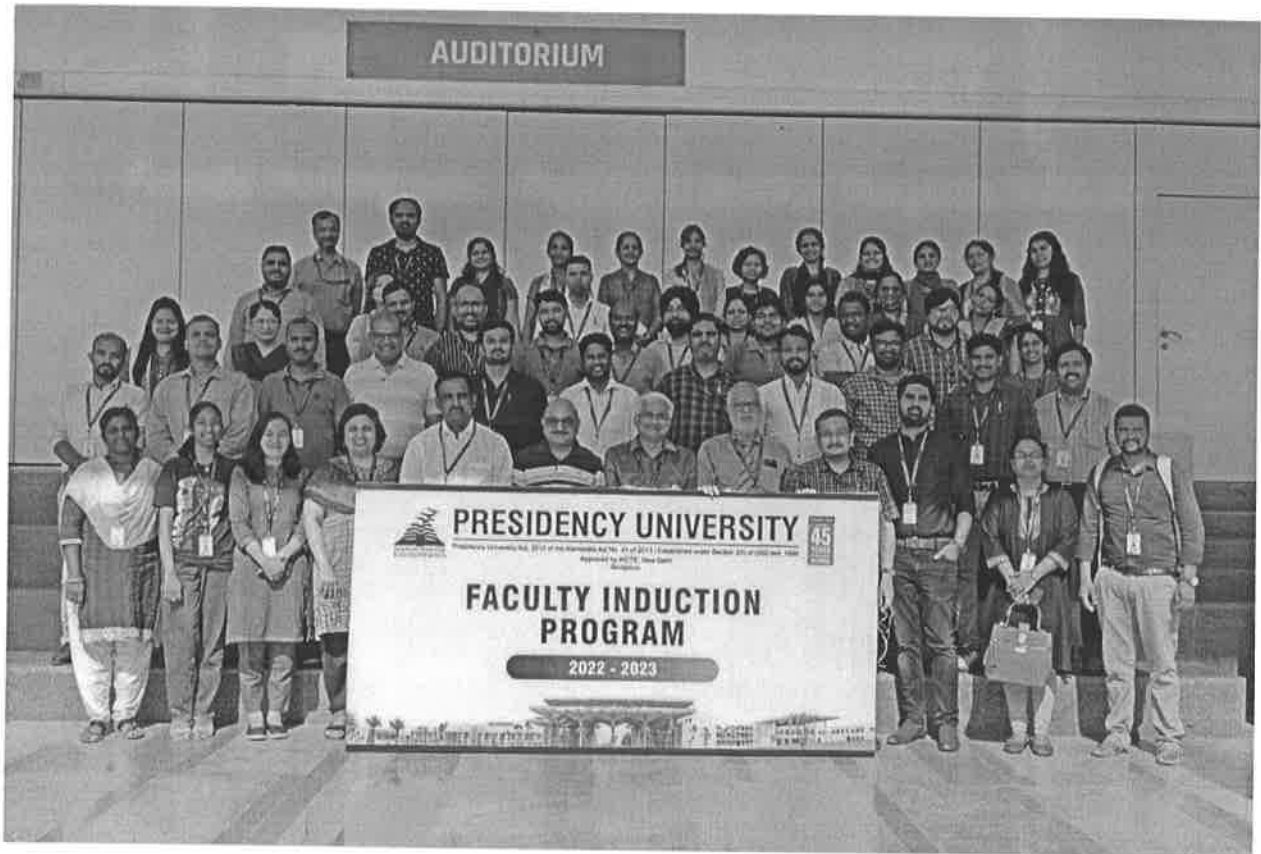

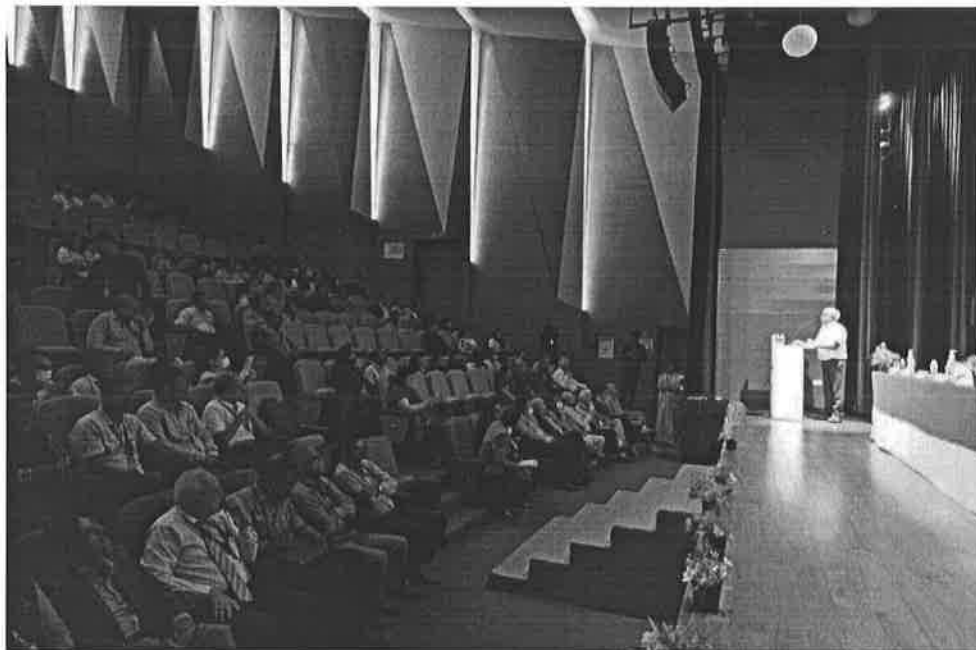

(On 4th, 10th, 11th, 24th, 25th August 2022 & 8th Sep 2022)

An offline review session on **Course handouts (CHOs) preparation** was conducted by respected Dr. Shilpa Mehta, Dean Academics to all the Department / School in presence of all the Department / School faculty members for all the courses mentioned in the forthcoming Fall (Odd) Semester 2022-23. The meeting was commenced by Dean Academics with the following agenda points were discussed and listed below:

Agenda No 1: Upgrading the Course Outcomes to higher cognitive levels as per Bloom's Taxonomy.

Dean Academics randomly audited the course handouts of all semesters like I, III, V and VII Semesters, suggested all the faculty members to upgrade the bloom's level of the course outcomes of higher semester courses to higher cognitive/Blooms level, wherever feasible and recommended to raise the level of teaching to upgrade the student's cognitive level. She also mentioned the following points:

- To choose the verbs in blooms taxonomy depending on the course content and the course delivery.
- Course outcomes should be applicable to all the students irrespective of student's attainment level in the exams.

Agenda No 2: Raise the level of teaching to analysis level wherever feasible

Dean Academics suggested all the faculty members to raise the level of teaching to analysis level especially in higher semesters so as to improve the employability ratio of the students.

Agenda No 3: Proper assignment of Course codes

Dean Academics conveyed that for the same type of course, the course code can be different as the course code represents a unique number. For eg. Digital electronics course can be taught to branches like Computer science Engineering, Electronics and communication Engineering and Electrical & Electronics Engineering with different course content but different course codes.

Agenda No 4: Verifying the PRC Reference number, Semester, Year

Dean Academics instructed all the faculty members to verify the PRC Reference number, Semester, Year properly in all the course handouts and update if any changes are required. She mentioned a uniform numbering scheme for PRC documents

Other discussion points:

1. The Library link in the CHO and Catalogues should be given from Nimbus Link.
2. The concept of writing Thought provoking questions and more number of questions should be added in the question papers.
3. Writing of Course outcomes, mapping it with Programme outcomes was discussed with relevant examples.
