The IQAC has been constituted adhering to the norms of its composition as per the NAAC guidelines with the Vice Chancellor as the Chairman of the committee, with external members nominated from local society, Students, Alumni, Employers/Industrialists and Stakeholders. The other internal members represent various academic & administrative Departments/Schools of the University.
