

# Report on Alumni Talk by Mr. Syed Sufyan "Study Abroad in Canada and PR Opportunities"

# **Introduction**:

On Friday, May 12, the Department of Civil Engineering, School of Engineering at Presidency University, Bengaluru, organized an alumni talk event featuring Mr. Syed Sufyan, a distinguished alumnus of the department. The talk, titled "Study Abroad in Canada and PR Opportunities," aimed to provide valuable insights and guidance to the students of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semesters of Civil Engineering. Mr. Syed Sufyan, currently pursuing his Master's degree at Toronto Metropolitan University, formerly known as Ryerson University, in Canada, shared his experiences and knowledge about studying abroad and the potential opportunities for Permanent Residency (PR) in Canada.

### **Event Overview:**

The event took place in the F Block Seminar Hall, starting at 1:30 PM. Mr. Syed Sufyan, was formally introduced to the audience by Mr. N. Gopalakrishnan. The organizers, FORCE - Forum of Civil Engineering, and the Department of Civil Engineering, facilitated an engaging environment for students to learn from the experiences of their accomplished alumnus. The session lasted for approximately one and half hours, including a presentation by Mr. Syed Sufyan followed by a question-and-answer session. # **Presentation Highlights:**

Mr. Syed Sufyan's presentation covered various aspects of studying abroad in Canada and the opportunities for securing Permanent Residency. He shared his personal journey, from his undergraduate studies at Presidency University to his current pursuit of a Master's degree in Canada. Key highlights from the talk included:

<u>Introduction to Canada as a Study Destination</u>: Mr. Sufyan provided an overview of the Canadian education system, highlighting its quality, diversity, and global recognition. growth.

He discussed the pathways available for international students to transition from study permits to work permits and eventually securing PR status.

Students had the opportunity to seek clarifications and further insights from Mr. Sufyan regarding their concerns, including application processes, scholarships, work opportunities, and the overall student experience in Canada.
