- Identity Card (For the wards of J & K / North East Migrants, NRI, SAARC & FOREIGN), Issued by the concerned Deputy Commissioner / Resident Commissioner. (4 Copies)

Hostel facilities:

Those who are willing to avail the hostel facilities are required to confirm by paying Rs. 10,000/- refundable caution deposit and yearly hostel charges as applicable. Hostel is purely on first come first serve basis. The hostel charges are Rs.1,05,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Five Thousand Only) per year for triple occupancy room and Rs.1,40,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Forty Thousand only) for Girls and Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) for Boys per year for Double occupancy room and with multi cuisine vegetarian and non-vegetarian food.

Students are requested to comply with the hostel rules and regulations, maintain cordial behaviour with the concerned authorities and coordinators, and be responsible for all your personal belongings.

ABOUT BANGALORE:

Bangalore, also known as Bengaluru (Kannada) is the capital of the Indian State of Karnataka. Bangalore is nicknamed as the Garden City and was once called a Pensioner's Paradise. Located on the Deccan Plateau in the south-eastern part of Karnataka, Bangalore is India's third most populous city. There are a number of expats from across the world living in the city, thanks to the growing presence of Multi-National Companies.

The centre of India's high-tech industry, the city is also known for its parks and nightlife. By Cubbon Park, Vidhana Soudha is a Neo-Dravidian legislative building. Former royal residences include 19th-century Bangalore Palace, modelled after England's Windsor Castle, and Tippu Sultan's Summer Palace, an 18th-century teak structure.

Today as a large city and growing metropolis, Bangalore is home to many of the most well-recognized colleges and research Institutions in India. Numerous public sector heavy industries, software companies, aerospace, telecommunications, and defence organizations are located in the city. Bangalore is known as the Silicon Valley of India because of its position as the nation's leading IT exporter. A demographically diverse city, Bangalore is a major economic and cultural hub and the fastest growing major metropolis in India.

CLIMATE:

The weather in Bangalore during Aug-Sept is breezy, pleasant and with mild showers. Bangalore's weather is generally pleasant throughout the year, we encourage you to pack light-warm clothing, waterproof clothing and an umbrella.

Situated at a height of 949 meters (3113 ft.) above the sea level, the city is blessed with salubrious climate throughout the year. Till the beginning of nineties, most of the homes in Bangalore didn't need fans. In summer while the rest of India wilted in the heat, Bangaloreans would snuggle under warm blankets at night. The city has dry tropical savannah type of climate. The rains are very frequent and the summers are warm. Winters are cold. But no weather goes to its extreme. One can visit the city any time of the year and enjoy the pleasant climate.

In summer the maximum temperature can rise to 36°C while the minimum temperature can drop to 20°C. In winter the maximum temperature can rise to 27°C and fall to less than 17°C. In spite of the maximum weather of 36°C, Bangalore is considered to be one of the coolest cities of India. The monsoon begins in July and carries on till September. This is a lovely time when everything turns lush green. About 85% of the rainfall is recorded between 4 PM and 7 PM in the evening. Hence carrying an umbrella would be a wise thing to do. Bangalore has a pleasant climate. The city has a lot of greenery with trees lined up along both sides of most of the roads. The numerous gardens and parks, streets lined with trees are very soothing in what would have been a jungle of concrete.
