

Admission to B. Des Program 2020-2024:

Eligibility:

Prerequisite

- Passed 10+2 examination.
- Obtained at least 45% marks in the qualifying Examination.
Candidates currently appearing for the 12 or 10+2 grade and awaiting final examination results are eligible to apply, however admission will only be secured upon submission of grades as and when declared. It is mandatory to have passed the examination with marks as mentioned above.

Additional

- Portfolio of original creative work
- Evidence of creative skills, eg. writing, making, performing, drawing, crafts

Admission Process:

1. Application Form

a. Indian Applicants:

Candidates are required to fill up an Online **Application Form** to enrol for the Entrance Test. Application fee is INR 1000/- for Indian students. Form can be filled and submitted online along with the Scanned copy of Grade 10 ('O' Level) results and any of the id proof.

b. NRI & International Applicants:

Candidates are required to fill up an Online **Application Form** to enrol for the Entrance Test. Application is free of cost for international students. Form can be filled and submitted online. Scanned copy of Grade 10 ('O' Level) results and valid Passport (National ID/ PIO Card) need to be forwarded at international@presidencyuniversity.in along with the Application Form.

2. Entrance Test

Admission to the B. Des Program is subject to qualification in PUDET (Presidency University Design Entrance Test)

1st Level: Online Test Presidency University Design Entrance Test (PUDET)

The first level of entrance test will be conducted through online mode. The Login credentials will be created and shared with the shortlisted candidates by the Controller of Examination, Presidency University.

Details of Online Test:

• **General Knowledge & Logical Understanding**

A written test comprising of general questions about society, culture, environment, general reasoning, critical and logical thinking.

- **Expression of Interest**

Students are required to share a **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE** as part of the online test. Online test is completed with a self written statement of interest. This needs to be uploaded by the candidates at the time of the online test.

Guidelines for STATEMENT OF PURPOSE (about 500 words):

An integral part of the entrance test, this phase requires each applicant to write a declarative sentence which summarizes the specific topic and goals, interests and skills and any other information the applicant deems fit to explain the intent for applying to the particular program. Applicants should self-write this essay and can share their ideas and aspirations.

3. **2nd Level: Studio Test**

a. Indian Applicants:

Studio Test will be conducted in the Presidency University campus in Bengaluru for Indian applicants.

b. NRI & International Applicants:

Studio Test will be in the online mode via Video / Skype/ Zoom Call, for international applicants.

Details of Studio Test:

- **Aptitude Test**

A test of creative skills, problem-solving, making and doing in 2-D and 3-D formats.

- **Personal Interaction**

An interaction with a panel of experts to present ideas and creative work. Interaction comprises of portfolio review comprising of original creative work and Q&A.

(In order to secure admission, it is mandatory for every applicant to complete and pass all three tests)

4. **Result Announcement:**

Test result will be declared by the University Admissions Office, as declared by the SOD Dean office.

5. **Admission Offer:**

a. Indian Applicants:

Student will be issued Online Admission Offer Letter for transfer of Registration Fee ie INR 25000/-

b. NRI & International Applicants:

Student will be issued Online Admission Offer Letter and Fee Due Invoice for transfer of Registration Fee ie USD350.

Payment of Fee & Confirmation:

Student need to share the SWIFT ADVICE from the bank for confirmation of registration fee deposit via email to : international@presidencyuniversity.in

Admission Acceptance:

Acceptance/Admission Letter will be issued to the student once registration fee is paid. Detailed information and instructions regarding program and joining formalities will also be shared with the acceptance/admission letter.

For NRI & International Students:

Acceptance Letter will be issued to the international student for VISA application at the Nearest Indian Embassy in his/her Home country. Student Visa will be endorsed in the name of Presidency University and to student B Design Program in India.

Fee Payment : Remaining Fee for Program, including Hostel Fee (if applied for) will need to be transferred within 15 days of receiving Acceptance Letter. All Fee Transfer details and SWIFT Advice must be sent to Presidency University via email prior to the joining date at international@presidencyuniversity.in
