Subject: Hostel Facility Enrolment

Greetings from Presidency University!

A warm welcome to all the students who have been granted "Provisional Admission" to the B.Tech Undergraduate Programs at Presidency University for the Academic Year 2026-27. We draw the attention of the students desiring to avail the Facility of Hostel Accommodation for the Academic Year 2026-27, to the following.

- Students should register themselves by completing the Hostel Registration form and paying the requisite fee through Linways Portal (ERP). The login credentials for accessing the Linways portal have already been sent to the email address provided by the student at the time of admission.

Registration Process

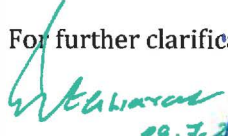
1. Log in to the ERP Portal – <https://presidencyuniversity.linways.com/>
2. Click on the "Apply Hostel" in the Top right corner
3. Fill in the required details and submit the form for fee generation.

Fee Payment:

- Students who have already remitted the Hostel Booking Amount are required to pay 50% of the applicable Hostel Fee to confirm their accommodation.
- Students who have not remitted the Hostel Booking Amount must first pay the prescribed booking amount. Upon receipt of the booking amount, the balance hostel fee payable will be generated in the ERP portal which has to be remitted.
- Registration shall be deemed complete only upon payment of the requisite fee. Hostel room allotment will be made only after the student has remitted the prescribed Hostel Booking Amount and 50% of the applicable Hostel Fee.
- Students shall carry their personal belongings viz., pillow, bedcover, blanket, bucket, warm cloths, umbrella, rain gear, toiletries etc in addition to their regular attire.
- Students should provide their previous medical records to the Hostel authorities in case of any existing health issues.
- Students should provide the Address proof/Aadhar card copy, photo and contact details of the Parents/Local Guardian.
- Students should not carry any expensive item/s. The Hostel Management will not accept responsibility for the loss of or damage to such items.
- All claims and matters pertaining to hostel accommodation shall be subject to the Hostel Policy of the University. Students are advised to read the Hostel Policy carefully before proceeding.

Please note that the room allotment will be on First-Come-First-Serve Basis.
