Report on Faculty Exchange Program at IQS University, Barcelona, Spain Dr. Prachi Beriwala, Associate Professor, School of Management

I am grateful to Presidency university for providing me this opportunity. This faculty exchange program at IQS University has been a transformative experience for me in terms of fostering collaboration, cultural exchange, and professional growth.

One of the most enriching aspects of this program was the great opportunity for me to immerse in a new cultural environment. I got to teach three different topics to different course students. The topics taught were Business culture in India, Business ethics in India & consumer behaviour in India. It was a great learning experience and I was able to give them a lot of insight about Indian traditions & culture in general. During my visit to IQS, I got to interact with colleagues from diverse backgrounds and a lot of mindful discussion happened in terms teaching, student's attitude and research.

I extended my proposal in terms of collaboration about SoM's upcoming academic conference with the Dean, IQS. A meeting with leadership team, international office team, career development cell along with our students pursuing master program at IQS university was organized to understand about the challenges students faced at the time of seeking admission at IQS and initial challenges in terms of accommodation at Barcelona. A lot of brain storming happened and it was decided that international office, IQS will be preparing a checklist along with our students to overcome such challenges. They will extend their support in terms of teaching Spanish language, paid internships, social security number and placement for one year to Presidency students doing 1+1 program at IQS University. They will also extend their help in Visa approval and residential accommodation to our students.

Dean, IQS and International office express their willingness for sending and inviting faculty to teach course. I also visited legal office of IQS university who expressed their concern about non- acceptance of Provisional degree certificates for seeking admissions by Spain government and suggested that student must carry legalised degree before starting course at Barcelona.

Apart from challenges I faced in terms of logistical processes such as visa applications, currency exchange and travel arrangements, the Faculty Exchange Program at IQS University has been instrumental in promoting collaboration, cultural exchange, and professional development. By fostering international networks, enhancing teaching and research practices, and facilitating personal growth, the program contributes to the Presidency university's global engagement and academic excellence.

Once again I thank everyone for giving me this opportunity.
