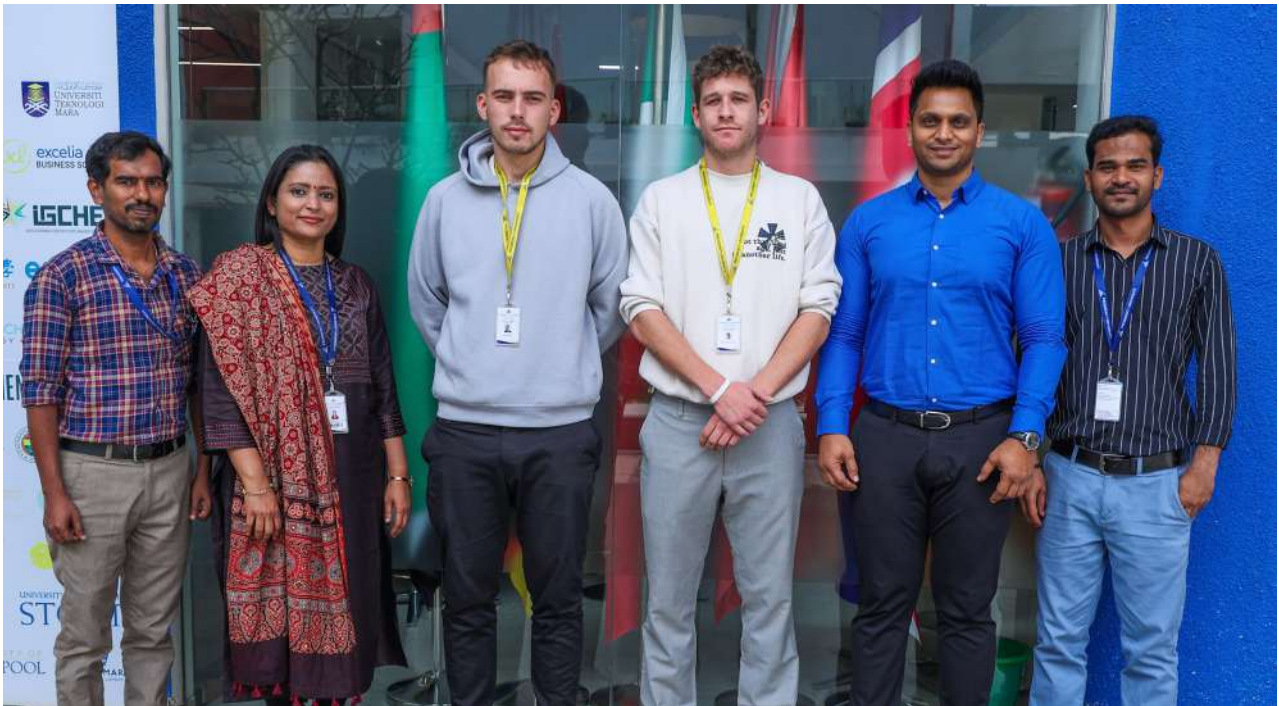
STEM-Education Tour 2024 @ Presidency University, Bengaluru
