Eligibility

B.Des.

The candidate seeking admission to the B.Des. programme must have passed Pre-University/Higher Secondary/10+2 Examination with Arts/Commerce/Science stream and obtained at least 45% marks & 40% in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST and other reserved categories.

B.Sc. Multimedia

Candidates seeking admission to B.Sc. Multimedia must have passed (10+2)/PUC or equivalent examination with minimum of 40% marks in aggregate.

B.Sc. Multimedia

The B.Sc. It covers audio/video production, web and mobile app development, and more, offering diverse career opportunities in film, gaming, media, and design as animators, graphic designers, content developers, and storyboard writers.

B.Des. Specialisations Offered

Product Design

This specialisation explores the relationship between products, systems, and end-users, emphasising innovation with social, ecological, and technological impact. Students develop expertise in digitally integrated products, lifestyle, and accessory design while gaining skills in cognitive factors, studio work, and material utilisation. Hands-on projects provide a platform to showcase their creative talents.



Space Design

This specialisation aims at enabling students to deal with space and the built environment with a focus on designing or upscaling interiors, exteriors, or conceptualising and layout planning for exhibitions and museums by incorporating urban designs and more.

Communication Design

This specialisation covers communication design fundamentals, allowing learners to focus on graphic design or visual representation through new media. It provides a deep understanding of both pathways, along with motion graphics and an introduction to special effects.

Fashion Design
