Agenda 26.9: Any Other Matter with Permission of the Chair


The following suggestions were put forward and recorded:

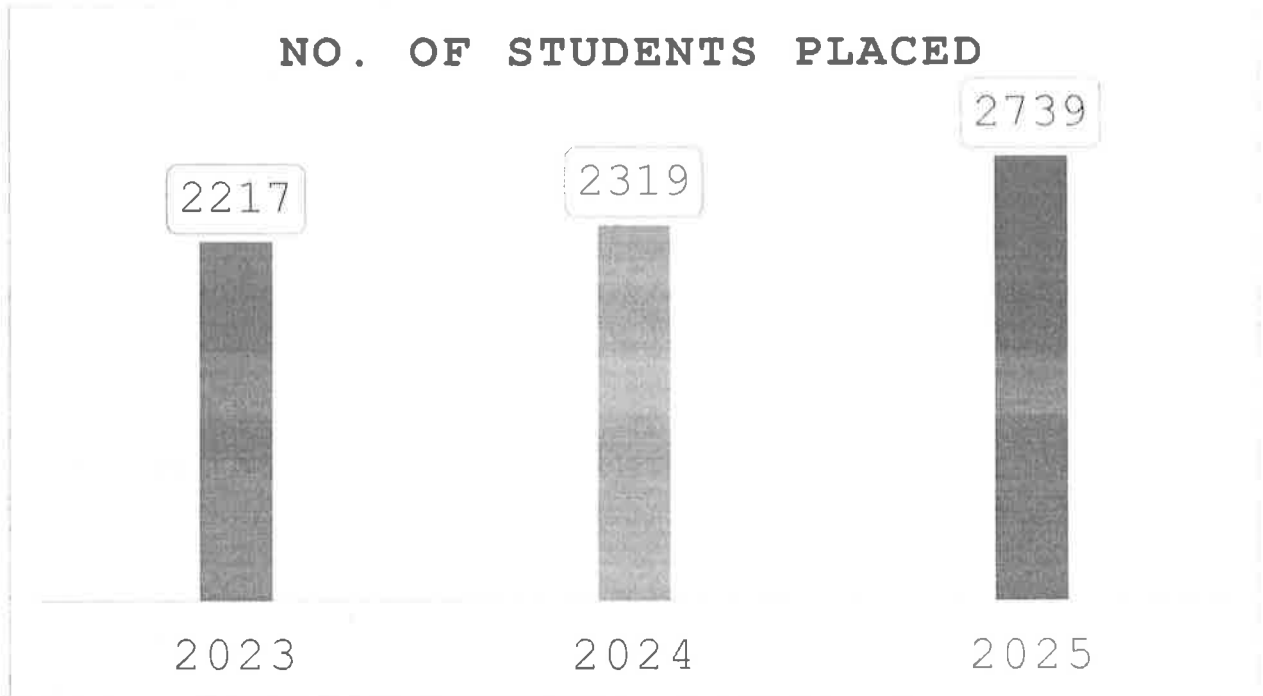
