Paper submission Guidelines

Papers are invited related to the subject and the subtheme of the conference. The paper should be in MS word file format and should be sent to the mail provided in the brochure. For further clarification, contact the organizing committee.

- Abstract should not exceed 250 words
- Submission must be original and should not have been previously published or submitted in any platform
- Paper should adhere to MLA's 9th edition, and the similarity index of the paper must be below 15%
- Include the details of author, co-author, affiliation, mail id, to avoid any correction in the proceedings
- Selected papers will be published in the Peer Reviewed Journals, and the intimation will be sent to the corresponding authors.
- For the papers with more than one author, all the authors must register individually to receive the certificate and other conference details.
- Papers should be in Times New Roman font size 12, Title preferably 16 in MS word document and should be submitted in the word format for the access to review.

- All registered and presented papers will be included in the official conference proceedings
- Selected papers will be published with an ISSN and will be indexed on Google scholar
- Any instructions and guidelines for publishing the paper will be instructed to the corresponding author.
- Acceptance in the conference note does not guarantee acceptance in journals.
