Faculty Orientation on IndiaSkills 2025





About the Event	SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), SDG 9 (Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure), SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals) The PU ISR Cell organised an online faculty orientation on IndiaSkills 2025 on 15 September 2025 to strengthen engagement with India's national and global skills ecosystem. The session covered competition structure, eligibility, student benefits, and the role of higher education institutions in mentoring students for participation at multiple levels.
	MSDE and NSDC resource persons outlined the national skilling framework, including PMKVY, NAPS, and the IndiaSkills—WorldSkills pathway, highlighting IndiaSkills as the qualifier for WorldSkills International. Discussions addressed skill categories, NSQF-aligned credits, industry mentorship, and placement opportunities.
	The session emphasised institutional responsibilities such as student outreach , registration support , mentoring , and preparatory activities .
