About the Event	Don't Drink & Drive: A Road Safety Awareness Initiative SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-Being), SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), SDG 16 (Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions), SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals) The Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) Cell, Presidency University, in collaboration with the Karnataka Police, organised a "Don't Drink & Drive" Road Safety Awareness Drive at MG Road to highlight the serious consequences of drinking and driving and to promote responsible road behaviour. The initiative employed an engaging street-play and public awareness interaction, with active participation from students of Allied Health Sciences, to communicate critical messages on road safety, respect for traffic laws, and the value of human life.
