EVENT DESCRIPTION:

ROUNDS:

ROUND 1: COGNO COLLISION (Day 1).

Analyse the threat, strategise your defence, and justify your decisions to the council. Innovation and feasibility are your only shields. Only the fearless move ahead to the final day.

FINAL ROUND: CEO CHAIR (Day 2)

"The board is watching." You've reached the heart of the Upside Down. Face a relentless panel of experts in a high-pressure environment. Handle rapid-fire questions, ethical dilemmas, and make split-second leadership calls while the world watches. One wrong move changes everything.
