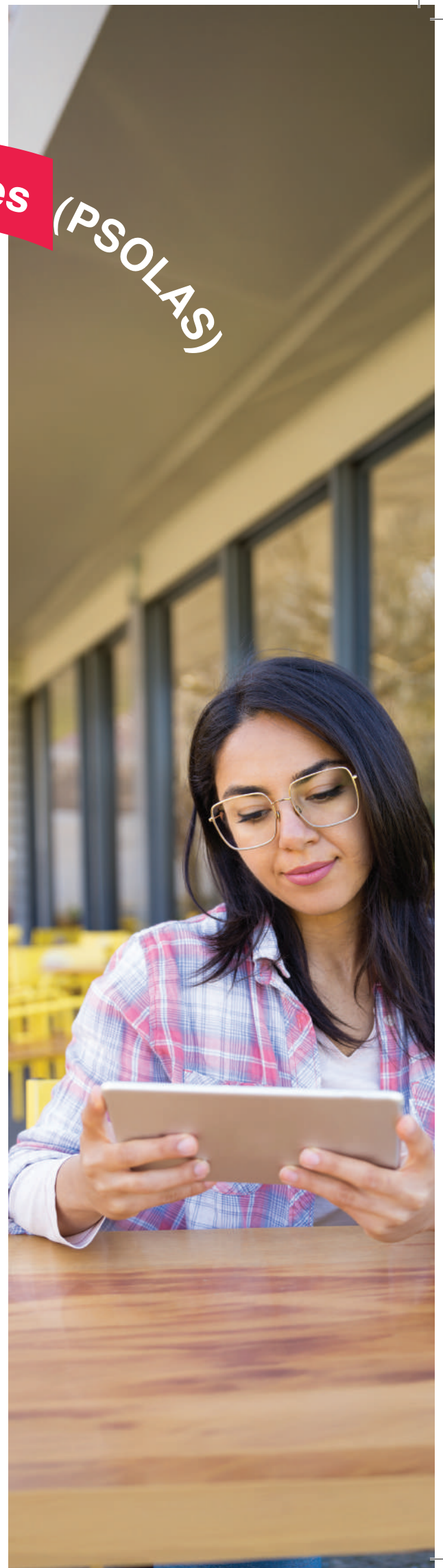

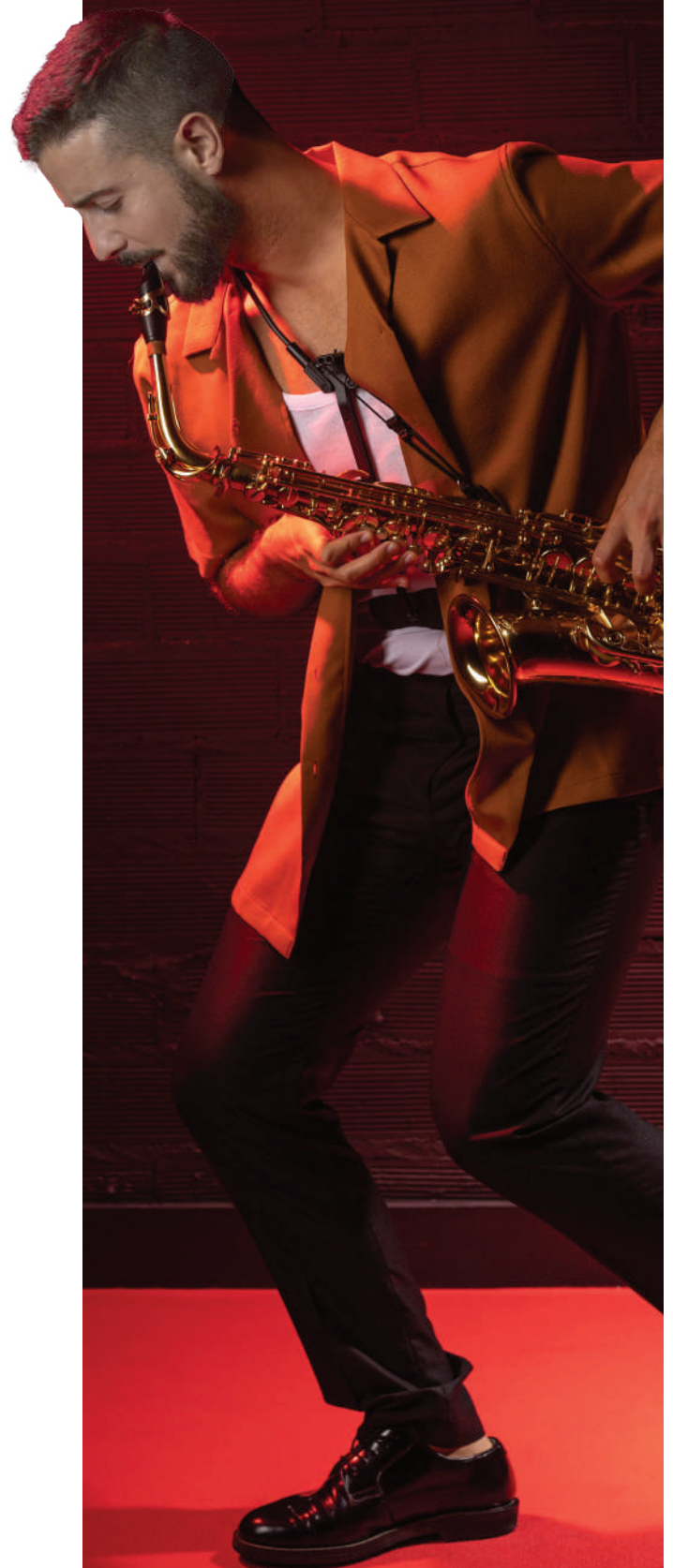

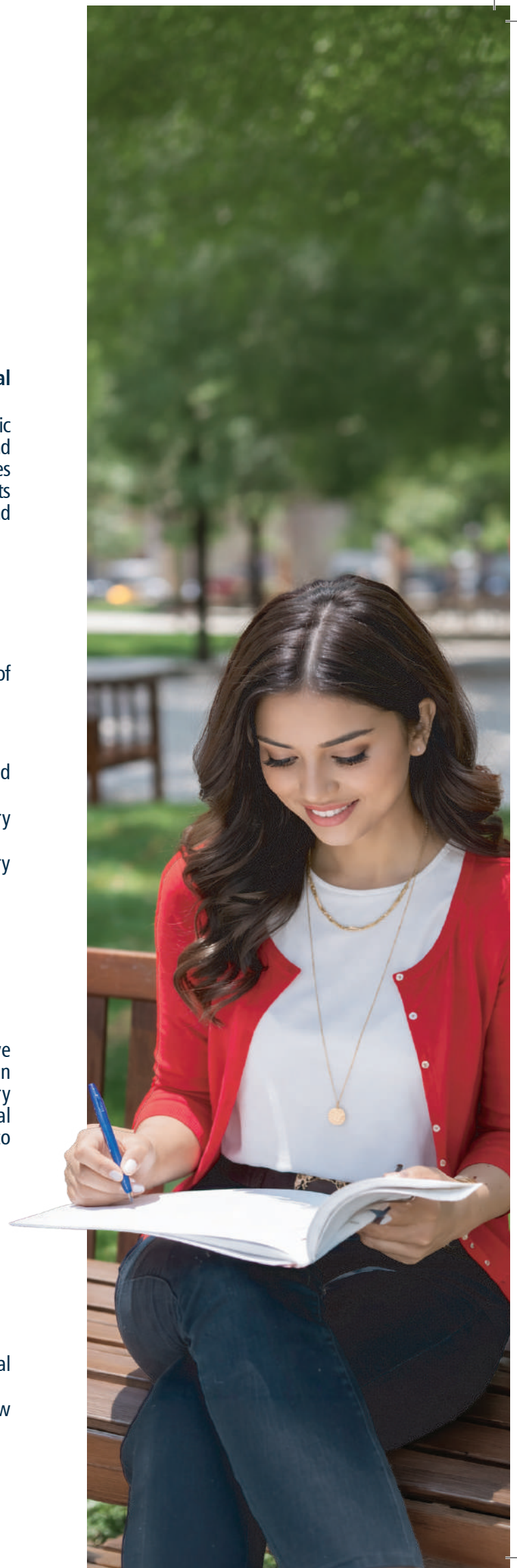

## PRESIDENCY LAUNCHPAD



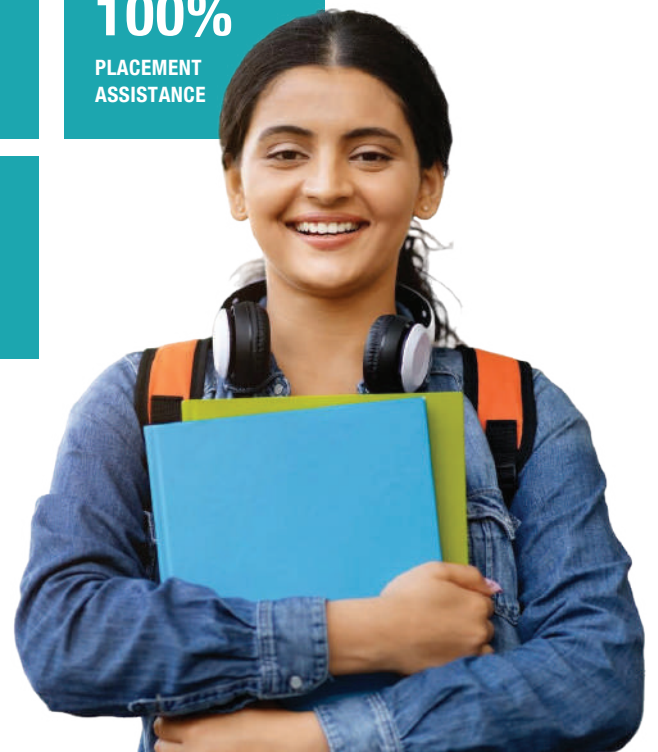

## PLACEMENTS

## LIBRARY



Spread across three locations, Presidency University's library system includes a main library in the Management Block, which houses reference books for the School of Engineering. Located adjacent to this is the Library Annexe, which offers an extensive collection of books in management and commerce. Additionally, a dedicated library serving the School of Law is located on the second floor of E Block.

The library system houses a collection of over 40,500 books and subscribes to 343 national and international journals, along with 45 magazines. It also provides access to 23 online databases covering Engineering, Law, Management, Design, and the Humanities.
