CURRICULUM

CHOICE-BASED CREDIT SYSTEM



Presidency University continuously strives to provide high quality, contemporary education to its students. In line with the dynamic nature of the higher education sector, the University transitioned to the Choice - Based Credit System (CBCS) from the academic year 2021-22, beginning with the first-year batch.

The CBCS curriculum framework is well structured and comprises school core courses, programme core-courses, discipline electives, and open electives. Additionally, projects are included to reinforce learning outcomes through experiential learning.

The knowledge and skills acquired through this model of higher education provide students with a platform to apply their learning to real time problem solving. Under CBCS, students take responsibility for pursuing areas of interest, while teachers facilitate the transfer of knowledge and associated skill sets.

PEDAGOGY AND LEARNING EXPERIENCE

Outcome-Based Education

The outcome-based education adopted by Presidency University ensures that students develop a broad knowledge base across disciplines, along with a deep understanding of their chosen subjects.

Multidisciplinary Approach

In line with the recommendations of NEP 2020, students at Presidency University are exposed to a multidisciplinary approach to education.

They have the opportunity to choose courses of interest from relevant and contemporary course baskets, enabling them to build a portfolio that supplements their core courses or discipline electives while also complementing each other. In essence, learning is not confined within the narrow boundaries of a single discipline.



Life Skills

Graduates of the University are expected to be not only industry-ready but also life-ready. The knowledge gained within the classroom is extended to the wider world through structured life skill training, as emphasised by NEP 2020.

Students gain practical experience in life skills and are equipped to perform daily tasks with confidence and competence.

The Life Skills programme is designed such that every student completes twenty activities during their time at the University. These activities are multidisciplinary in nature, with faculty drawn from diverse disciplines. Each activity typically ranges from 30 to 90 minutes, depending on its nature.

Learning & Development

The Department of Learning and Development was established in 2017 at Presidency University to bridge the gap between industry and academia.

It focuses on developing the required knowledge, skills, and attitudes among students, preparing them with the competencies needed to succeed in the corporate environment. The L&D team leads several initiatives at the University, including placement boot camps, employability workshops, speakathons, scavenger races, the Book-a-Day Challenge, and more.

The modules offered fall into three primary categories:

- **Aptitude training** (verbal ability, an quantitative reasoning and logical reasoning)
- **Technical skills** (critical thinking and problem-solving)
- **Communication skills** (interview etiquette and corporate etiquette)

The Department of Learning and Development also collaborates with the HR department to train faculty on topics such as growth mindset, workplace skills and etiquette, and personality development.



INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATIONS

Presidency University has established collaborations with more than 165 premier institutions across 33 countries for academic and research cooperation. These collaborations create strategic opportunities for the mutual benefit of students and faculty across partner institutions worldwide.

The Office of International Affairs (OIA) has been established to provide international exposure to every student at Presidency. It offers a range of opportunities and supports both students and faculty in promoting internationalisation within the University.

OIA works to establish new collaborations with renowned institutions globally while sustaining existing partnerships. It collaborates closely with various stakeholders across schools and departments to facilitate internationalisation at home.

The Office also supports departments and schools in organising joint events such as webinars, workshops, and conferences in collaboration with international partner institutions.

Interaction sessions with successful alumni abroad are organised to bring together second, third, & final year students. These sessions help current students gain clarity on opportunities, lifestyle and cost of living, visa processes, higher education pathways, and career prospects following semester exchange programmes or research internships.

Presidency University is registered under the Study in India (SII) programme, a flagship initiative of the Ministry of Education, Government of India. The programme aims to position India as a leading destination for international students by offering access to high-quality higher education.

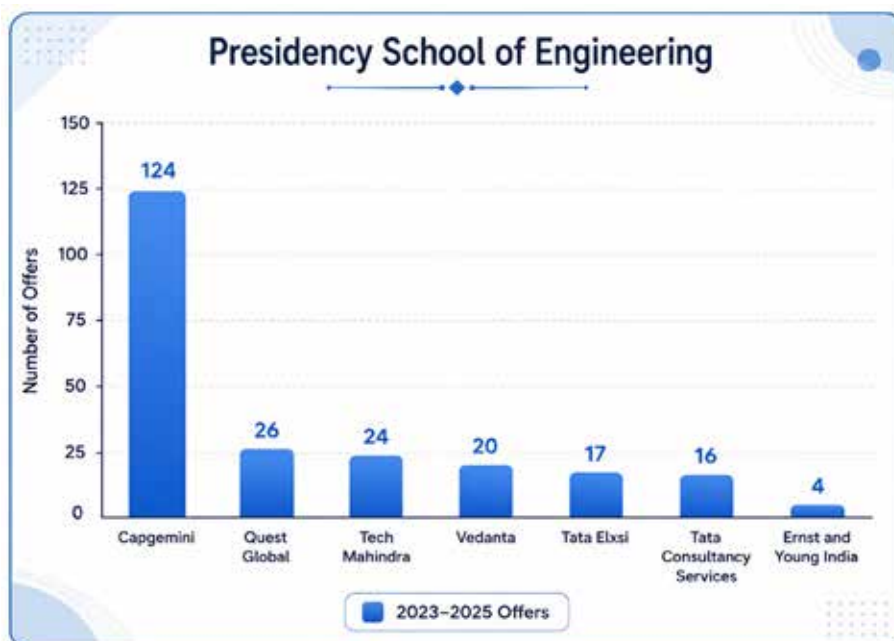
Japanese – The Language of Precision and Culture
