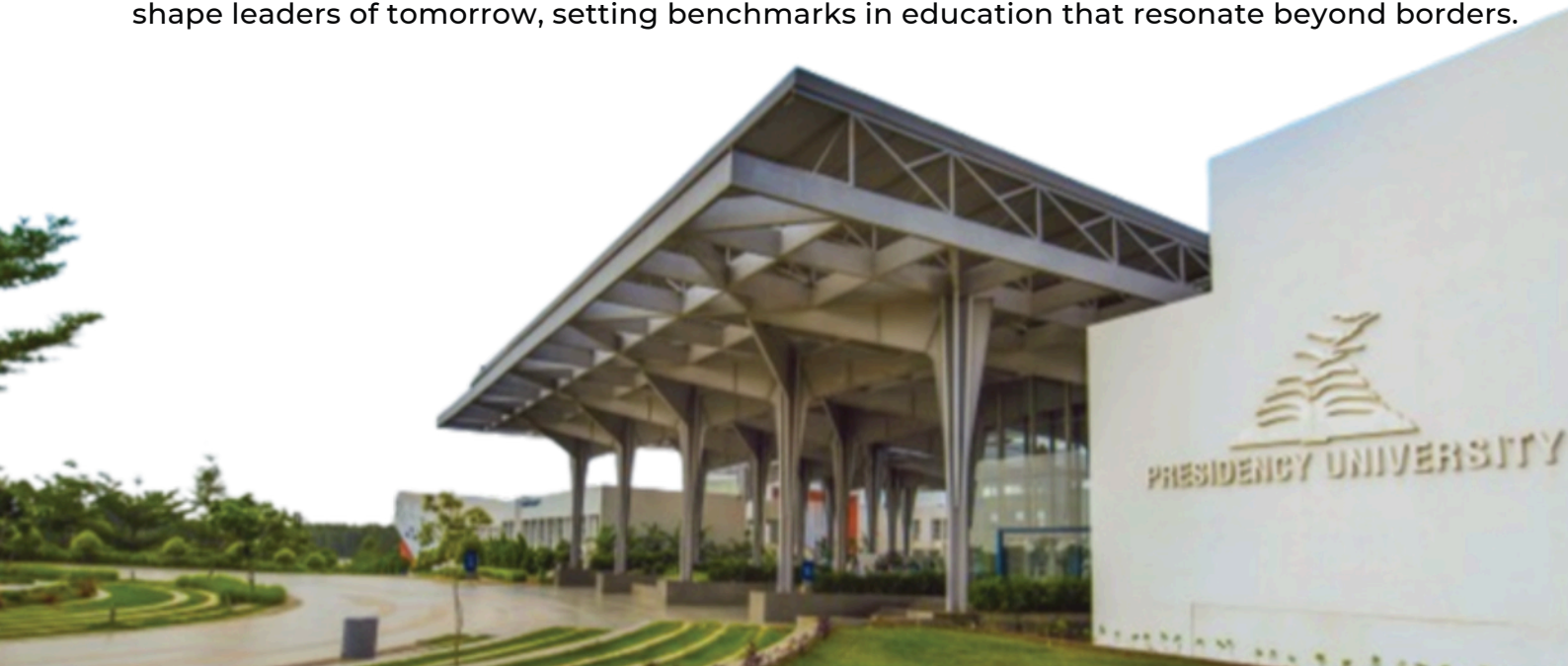

The competition offers participants a comprehensive and immersive experience by integrating a multi-stage Boardroom Simulation Competition with a simulated National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) Trial, enabling them to engage with complex corporate decision-making, governance challenges, and dispute resolution in a realistic setting.

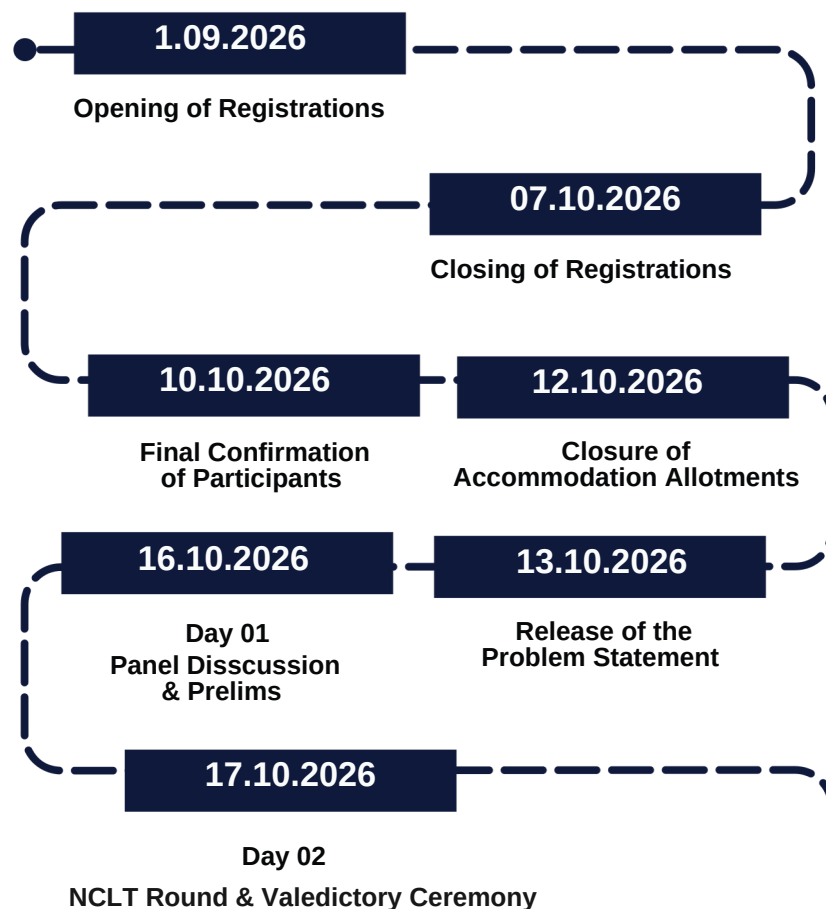
TEAM FORMATION

Participation takes place in two modes:

Team Participation: Each institution may nominate teams consisting of five (5) members, with each member being assigned a distinct role (Chairperson, Company Secretary, Independent Director, External Legal Counsel, Small Shareholder Director).

Individual Participation: Students may also register individually. Such participants will be grouped into composite teams by the Organising Committee and will be informed of their final team composition at least seven (7) days before the commencement of the Workshop. The allocation of roles ensures representation of strategic, legal, financial, and shareholder perspectives, thereby mirroring real-world governance challenges.
