

INAUGURATION OF THE STUDENT ACTIVITIES, SCHOOL OF LAW

23rd September 2017

The inauguration of the student activities for the School of Law for academic year 2017-18 took place on the 23rd of September, 2017 in the state of the art auditorium in the university campus. The activities for the students of the law school are designed to help them develop expertise in personal, professional and practical skills which will help them excel in their chosen field of work. At the outset an inspiring welcome address was delivered by Dr. Sapna S, Dean, School of Law, in the presence of The Hon'ble Chief Guest, The Hon'ble Chancellor and the other distinguished officers of the university. The inauguration laid the groundwork for planned activities like debate, client counselling, moot court, judgement writing and crime scene investigation among others in the academic year. The activities also include the setting up of a Legal Aid Clinic as a gateway for the students to interact with the outside world. The Legal Aid Clinic at Presidency University in collaboration with the Karnataka State Legal Services Authority will provide students an opportunity to interact with judges of high courts and learn how to address the everyday legal issues faced by the common people.







Hon'ble Mr. Justice Raghavendra S Chauhan, sitting judge of The High Court of Karnataka was the chief guest for the inauguration. He opened up to the students as a mentor, father figure and friend and urged them to cross examine him. The students were prompt in taking the cue and asked a volley of guestions to him about his life as a lawyer, the difficulties that he faces as a judge and his views on the legal fraternity. He pointed out that there is no area of knowledge which law will not deal with so a law student must take to reading as a fish takes to water. He guoted John Roberts, the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the the United States and pointed out that, I hope that you have a very tough time in the law school as disappointments teach us how to lead our lives. He asked the students to be humble with increasing success and urged them to look at law from different perspectives like streams flow into an ocean. He cited cases to explain the law points to the students which were very enriching for them. He told them the difference between a good lawyer and a great one. The students had a wonderful session listening to the experience of the judge. They have been inspired to become great lawyers and judges in future.
