## CIRCULAR

Sub: Fee for the Academic Year 2020-21 [Odd Semester]

This is further to our Circular No. PU/2020/41 dated 27th November, 2020 on the Captioned Subject.

The Students will appreciate that Online Classes for the Academic Year 2020-21 have been in progress since August 10, 2020. Some Students have remitted their Fee for the entire Academic Year while many more have remitted the Odd Semester Fee [50% of the Fee for the entire Academic Year]. We still find, from the records, that a few Students have not made any payment so far, since the commencement of Online Classes and a sizeable number of Students have remitted less than the requisite Odd Semester Fee.

In this direction, we wish to inform you that per the Regulations of the University, Students should remit at least 50% of the Annual Fee [Odd Semester Fee], before the commencement of the Odd Semester Classes. However, keeping the trying circumstances, in mind, the University had extended the last date for payment of the Odd Semester Fee to December 10, 2020, only for the current Academic Year.

Please also note the following Guidelines in respect of Fee Payable by Students for the Academic Year 2020-21

- Given the Covid-19 Pandemic and appreciating the situation, the Fee has been retained at the same structure as Academic Year 2019-20, payable in two [2] equal Installments.
- Further, Fee, otherwise payable, by Students, has been reduced by Rs. 10,000 for the Academic Year 2020-21 only.
- Students who choose to pay the entire Fee of the said Academic Year in full, on or before December 10, 2020, will be offered a special one-time concession of Rs. 10,000/-.
- Should Students require any Loan from Financial Institutions, please do note that the University has entered into an arrangement with few Financial Institutions to facilitate the same and as a special support, the University will bear the interest arising from this Education Loan for the Academic Year 2020-21 only. Please do note that where the Fee of the Entire Academic Year is paid, in full, through the Proceeds of the Education Loan, discussed herein, the one-time concession of Rs. 10,000/- is not applicable. Students are directed to note that if the Odd Semester Fee is not remitted on or before December 10, 2020, the University reserves the right to not permit students to continue attending classes.
