CIRCULAR

Sub: Fee for the Academic Year 2020-21 [Odd Semester]

This is further to our Circular PU/2021/02 dated January 30, 2020 on the Captioned Subject and also the various other Fee-related Circulars issued thereafter, from time to time.

The Students will appreciate that Online Classes for the Academic Year 2020-21 have been in progress since December 16, 2020. Many students have remitted their Fee for the entire Academic Year while many more have remitted the Odd Semester Fee [50% of the Fee for the entire Academic Year]. Yet, we still find, from the records that a sizeable number of Students have remitted less than the requisite Odd Semester Fee.

In this direction, we wish to inform you that per the Regulations of the University, Students should remit at least 50% of the Annual Fee [Odd Semester Fee], before the commencement of the Odd Semester Classes. However, keeping the trying circumstances, in mind, the University had extended the last date for payment of the Odd Semester Fee to February 28, 2021, only for the current Academic Year.

Please also note the following Guidelines in respect of Fee Payable by Students for the Academic Year 2020-21

- Given the Covid-19 Pandemic and appreciating the situation, the Fee has been retained at the same structure as Academic Year 2019-20, payable in two [2] equal Installments.
- Should Students require any Loan from Financial Institutions, please do note that the University has entered into an arrangement with few Financial Institutions to facilitate the Education Loan for the Academic Year 2020-21 only, with the interest thereon for the Academic Year 2020-21 ONLY, being borne by the University, as special case.

Students are directed to note that if the Odd Semester Fee is not remitted on or before February 28, 2021, the University reserves the rights for not allowing the defaulting Students to appear for the forthcoming Examinations and not to permit them to continue attending Classes.
