Agenda 9.1

To approve the minutes of 8th Board of Studies Meeting held on 8th June, 2019

Comment: Board noted and approved the minutes of the 8th Board of Studies meeting.

Comment: The MBA Program Regulations, Structure and Curriculum from the I Semester to IV Semester of 2020-22 batch was discussed and deliberated in detail. The following changes were recommended:

- 1. The board discussed courses related to Virtual Working and Data Visualization and suggested to include them as a module in the curriculum of OB and Business Analytics courses.
- 2. The board appreciated various courses added to MBA Dual and Single Specialization Programs.
- 3. It was suggested to identify Power BI Course and add it to Business Analytics curriculum.
- 4. The board appreciated the ULC Courses as a part of MBA curriculum and suggested to relate ULC to working with NGO.
- 5. The board approved the list of MOOC Courses and suggested to add courses related to "Giving Space to team" and "Appreciative Enquiry".
- 6. The board suggested to include Fintech", "Digital Consumer Behaviour" and "Digital Product Management" which are E Commerce Specialisation Courses as elective courses to Finance specialisation students.
- 7. It was suggested to include a Course on Design Thinking and include topics related to business models and start- ups for Operations specialisation.
- 8. The board suggested to add tools, program languages, data extraction and linear modelling concepts in Business Analytics Curriculum.
- 9. It was suggested to add "Design Thinking" and "Tech products" as courses in Digital Transformation specialization.
- 10. The board suggested to include concept of "Art of Possibilities" under PD/Value Added Course.
- 11. The board appreciated the curriculum of E Commerce specialisation.
- 12. The board suggested to rename Course "Supply Chain Outsourcing" as "Supply Chain Sourcing".
- 13. The board authorized the Chairperson to add the proposed MOOC Courses upon their availability to MBA I, II & III Semesters.

Resolution: Resolved that the Program Regulations and Program Structure and Curriculum from I Semester to IV Semester of the 2020-2022 batch herewith appended as Annexure II; be and are hereby approved, with the necessary changes as recommended above.
