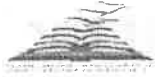
To consider and approve the Program Regulations Structure and Curriculum for MBA 2020 - 22 Batch:

Comment: The MBA Program Regulations, Structure and Curriculum from the I Semester to IV Semester of 2020-22 batch was discussed and deliberated in detail. The following changes were recommended:

1. The board discussed courses related to Virtual Working and Data Visualization and suggested to include them as a module in the curriculum of OB and Business Analytics courses.
2. The board appreciated various courses added to MBA Dual and Single Specialization Programs.
3. It was suggested to identify Power BI Course and add it to Business Analytics curriculum.
4. The board appreciated the ULC Courses as a part of MBA curriculum and suggested to relate ULC to working with NGO.
5. The board approved the list of MOOC Courses and suggested to add courses related to “Giving Space to team” and “Appreciative Enquiry”.
6. The board suggested to include Fintech”, “ Digital Consumer Behaviour” and “ Digital Product Management” which are E Commerce Specialisation Courses as elective courses to Finance specialisation students.
7. It was suggested to include a Course on Design Thinking and include topics related to business models and start- ups for Operations specialisation.
8. The board suggested to add tools, program languages, data extraction and linear modelling concepts in Business Analytics Curriculum.
9. It was suggested to add “Design Thinking” and “Tech products” as courses in Digital Transformation specialization.
10. The board suggested to include concept of “Art of Possibilities” under PD/Value Added Course.
11. The board appreciated the curriculum of E Commerce specialisation.
12. The board suggested to rename Course “ Supply Chain Outsourcing” as “ Supply Chain Sourcing”.
13. The board authorized the Chairperson to add the proposed MOOC Courses upon their availability to MBA I, II & III Semesters.

Resolution: Resolved that the Program Regulations and Program Structure and Curriculum from I Semester to IV Semester of the 2020-2022 batch herewith appended as Annexure II; be and are hereby approved, with the necessary changes as recommended above.

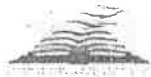

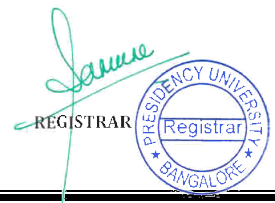

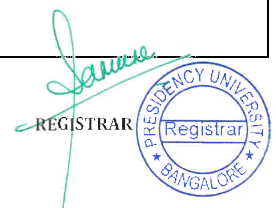
