The 1st general body meeting of the Student Grievance redressal cell of Presidency University was convened and held on 29-05-2021 at 2 PM, in virtual mode via the Zoom link

The Chairperson, Dr. Surendrakumar extended a warm welcome to all the members.

Points discussed:

- Meeting began with a warm introduction of all the members of the committee
- Member secretary Dr. Anu Sukhdev has read out the agenda of the meeting to all the members
- ➤ Dr. Snehaprabha, Director, DSA, informed the committee that DSA office is solving all trivial issues which has been brought to their notice, by connecting with the concerned schools/departments and the same is communicated to the students through mail.
- ➤ For any major issues, emergency meeting will be convened in the presence of higher official.
- > Students were asked to speak out the issues if any:
- Student started with a positive note and gratitude to the management for reducing the fee by Rs.10,000 which many felt beneficial during these unprecedented covid times
- > Student representatives put forth the following issues and all their queries were responded satisfactorily by Chairperson Prof. Surendrakumar.
 - a) Inability of fee payment on time by many students due to pandemic

Chairperson responded to the query saying that management is offering various flexible options like fee instalments, accepting post-dated cheques etc to reduce the burden on students and parents. To have more clarifications, they can contact Dr.Sheshadri , Senior librarian of the University.

b) Examination related issues

Students appreciated tremendous improvement in edhitch functioning compared to the last semester. But still students are facing few issues which has to be resolved.

Chairperson responded by saying that lot of improvements have been made in the exam portal. All their queries will be immediately solved by the



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Edhitch coordinator Prof Sudheendra and the exam cell and also advised them to mail to exam cell if any such problems arise which will be resolved on priority

c) Apprehension about Online internships

Chairperson has assured that final year online internships/projects are considered and has to be informed to the concerned department heads/Deans for processing to avoid delay in the results

d) Conduction of reexamination to avoid NE grade

Chairperson responded by saying that lot of re-exams are conducted to minimize the students falling under NE category. He has also mentioned the commendable job by Class -coordinators in coordinating with the students to take up the re-exam. Apparently, number of NE grades have been reduced. On the other side, students are not responding to the faculty calls.

Director, DSA informed that the mail id of point of contact to solve the issues of students will be sent to all students

e) Delay in offer letter from HCL

Associate Dean (SOM) Prof Krishnakumar assured that it will be taken up with HCL though placement director to resolve

f) Induction of research innovation cell

Chairperson has put forward that innovation incubation cells are already in place in the university and requested to contact Dr. Ramesh, Dean R and IC for further updates

Students appreciated the initiatives of DSA and its involvement on student activities

Meeting ended with an appreciation note from students to DSA Director, Prof Snehaprabha and Associate Dean Prof Krishnakumar in doing a commendable job for solving lot of issues and they expect to continue with the same.
