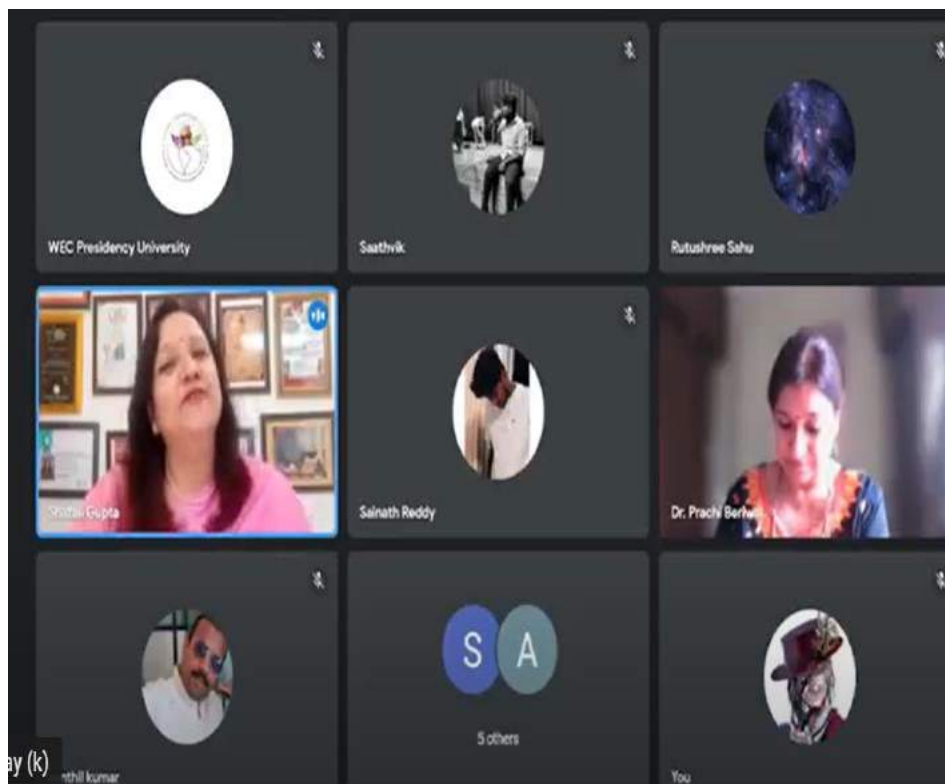

WEBINAR ON GENDER SENSITIZATION FOR THE SCHOOL OF COMPUTER SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING FACULTY

Presidency University, Department of Student Affairs organized a webinar on Gender Sensitization for the school of Computer Science and Engineering faculty on the 10th of September, 2022 from 10:00 am to 11:00 am on the topic "Gender Representation and gender sensitivity awareness"

Gender sensitization refers to the modification of behavior by raising awareness of gender equality concerns. It is also about changing behavior and instilling empathy into the views that we hold about our own and the other gender.

The guest speaker Dr. Neerja Pandey - Rehabilitation Psychologist, Integrated Clinical Hypnotherapist, and Assistant Professor of Psychology at Amity Institute of Behavioral & Allied Sciences (AIBAS) briefed about Gender sensitization and instances of Gender Discrimination. She also encouraged a general understanding of gender-related challenges, for instance, violence against women and the gender pay gap among faculty members. It focuses on how values and norms influence our reality, reinforce stereotypes and support the structures that produce inequalities. A total of 95 faculty members from the School of Computer science and Engineering participated in the Gender sensitization awareness program.

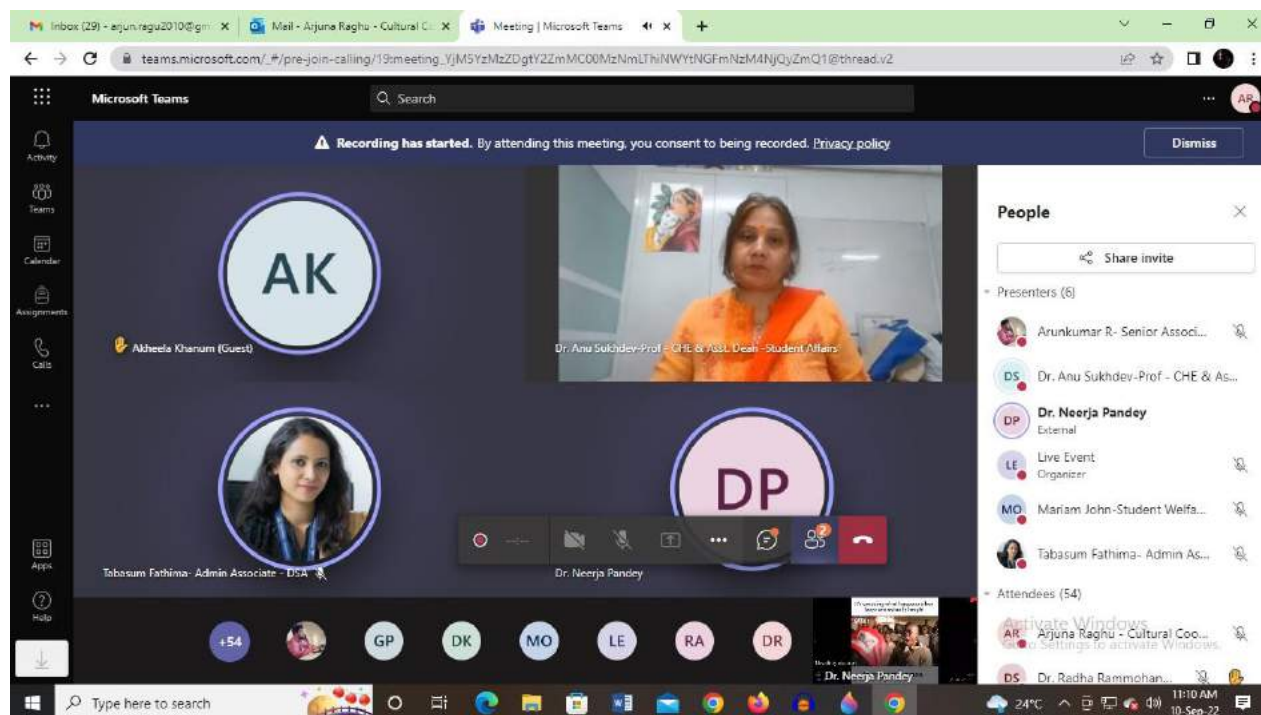

Gender Sensitization

- Gender sensitization refers to the modification of behaviour by raising awareness of gender equality concerns.
- Gender sensitization theories claim that modification of the behaviour of teachers and parents towards children can have a causal effect on gender equality.
- Gender sensitizing "is about changing behaviour and instilling empathy into the views that we hold about our own and the other gender. It helps people in "examining their personal attitudes and beliefs and questioning the 'realities' they thought they know.

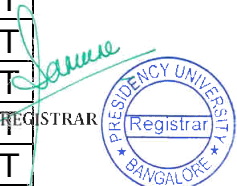

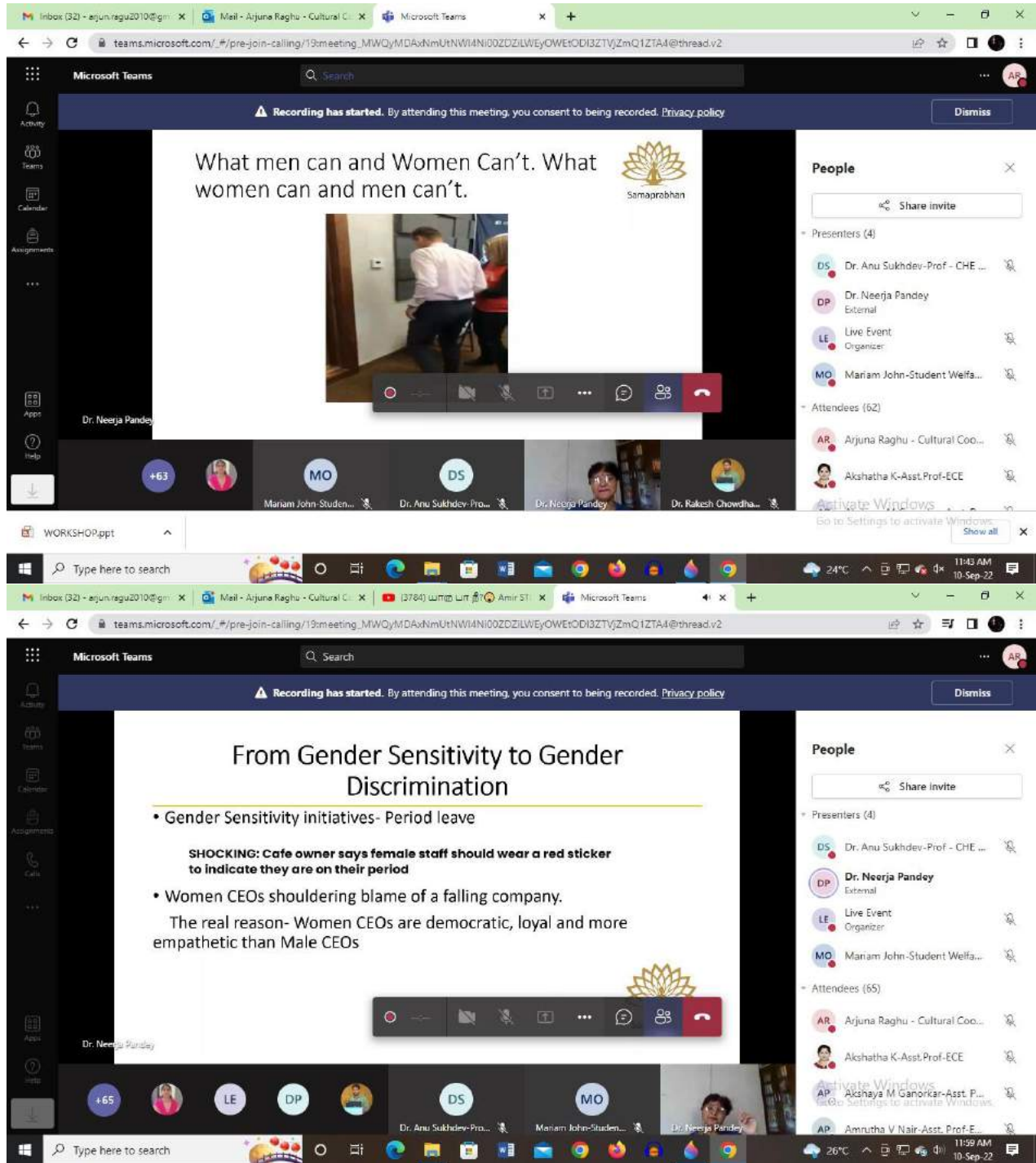

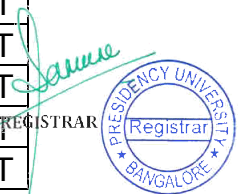



Picture: Guest speaker- Dr. Neerja Pandey webinar from gender sensitivity to Gender Discrimination

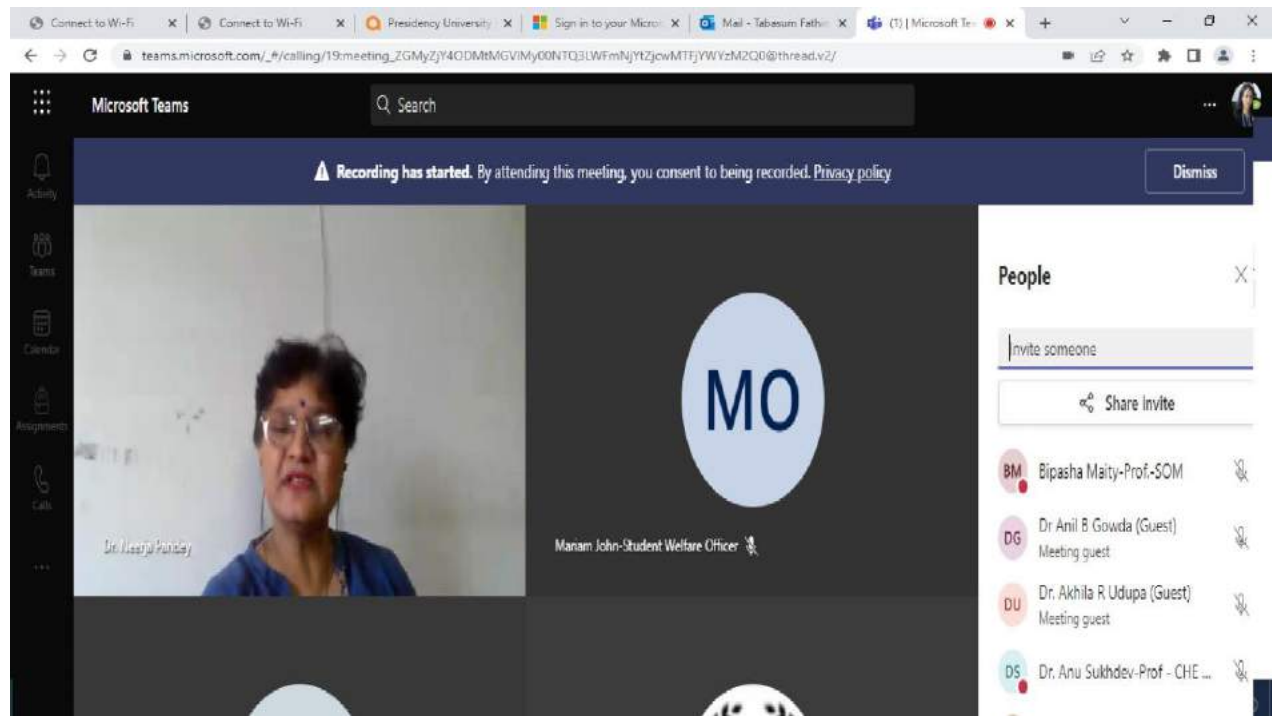

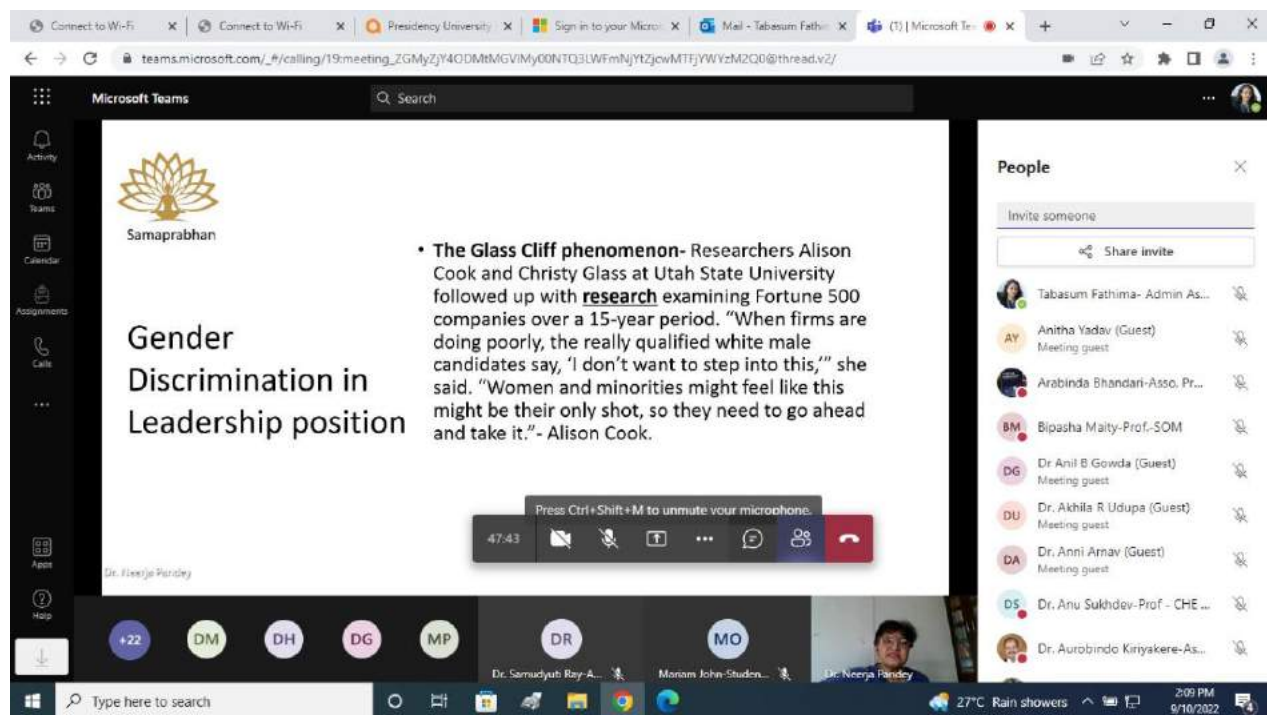


- **Hurdle No. 1: The Low Number of Women in Technical Fields**

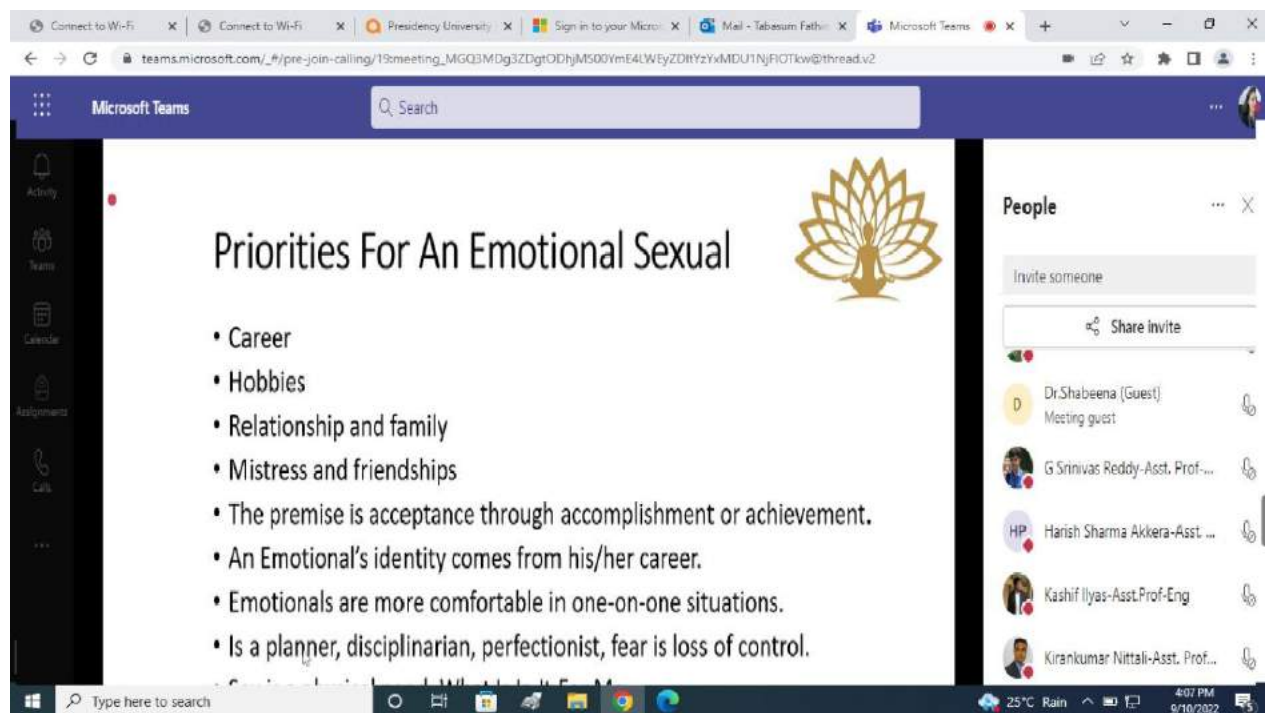

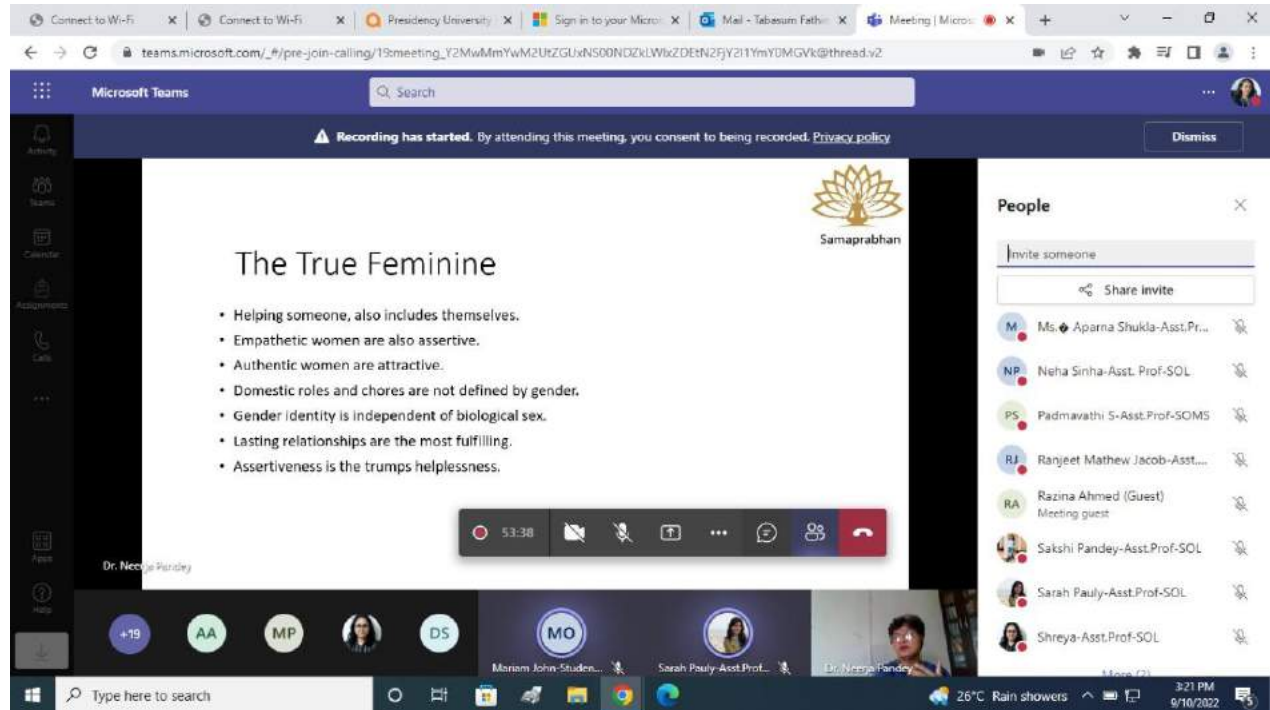

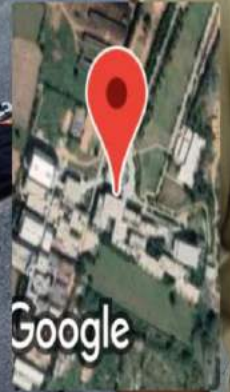

The session was wonderfully conducted by senior consultant Dr. Roopesh N Gynec-Oncologist. He shared knowledge about gynecologic cancer symptoms, risk factors, prevention, and early detection—because every five minutes, someone will be diagnosed with one of these cancers and over 33,000 will die from gynecologic cancer this year. The guest Speaker briefed about various cancers like Breast Cancer, Cervical Cancer, and Ovarian Cancer. The main objective was to educate and create awareness among the students and faculty members about the Cancer possibilities in women on the gynecological aspect. Dr. Roopesh N briefed the types of gynec cancers and reasons for cancer and also the ways to prevent them were shared with the audience. Indian women need to be aware of both modifiable and non-modifiable risk factors for breast cancer to adopt appropriate practices for prevention. Breast cancer is the most common cancer among women in India and most present at an advanced stage. Although early detection is the only way to reduce morbidity and mortality, people have a very low awareness of breast cancer signs and symptoms and screening practices. The purpose of this session was to assess the level of awareness and impact of awareness programs in the adoption of safe practices in prevention and early detection. Students and faculties of different schools participated in the awareness program and gained knowledge about the awareness, early detection, and prevention of gynec cancers.

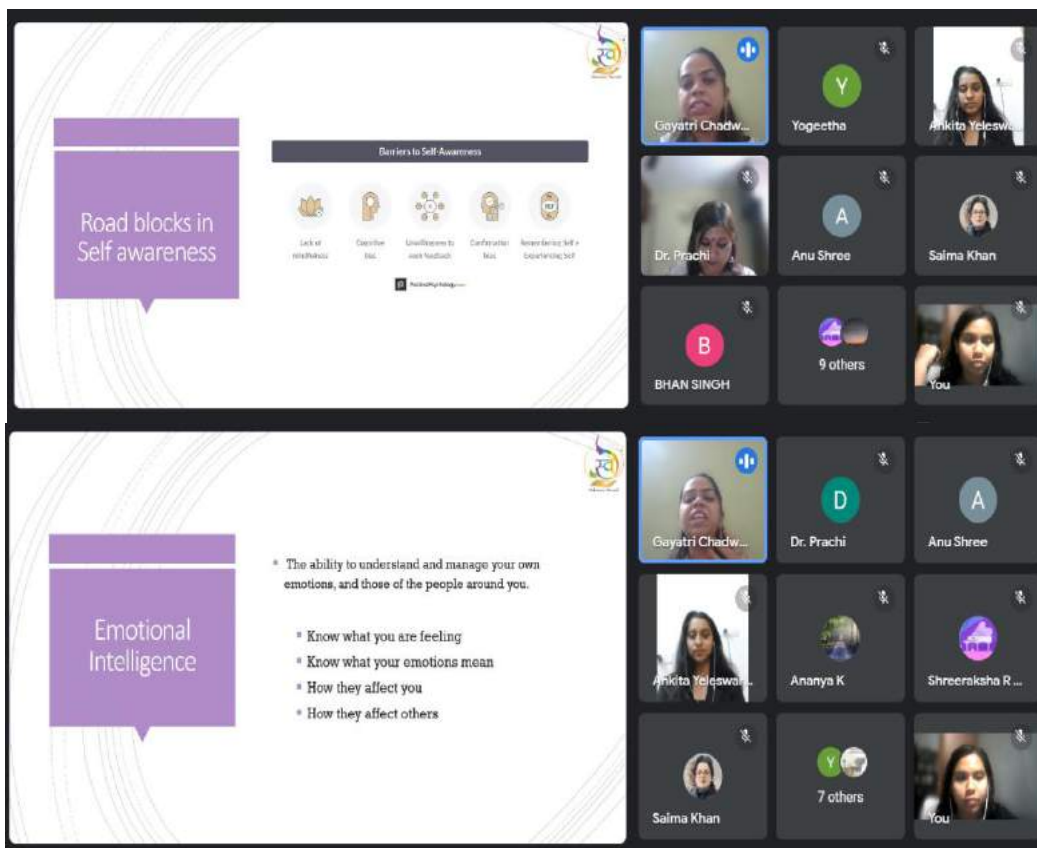

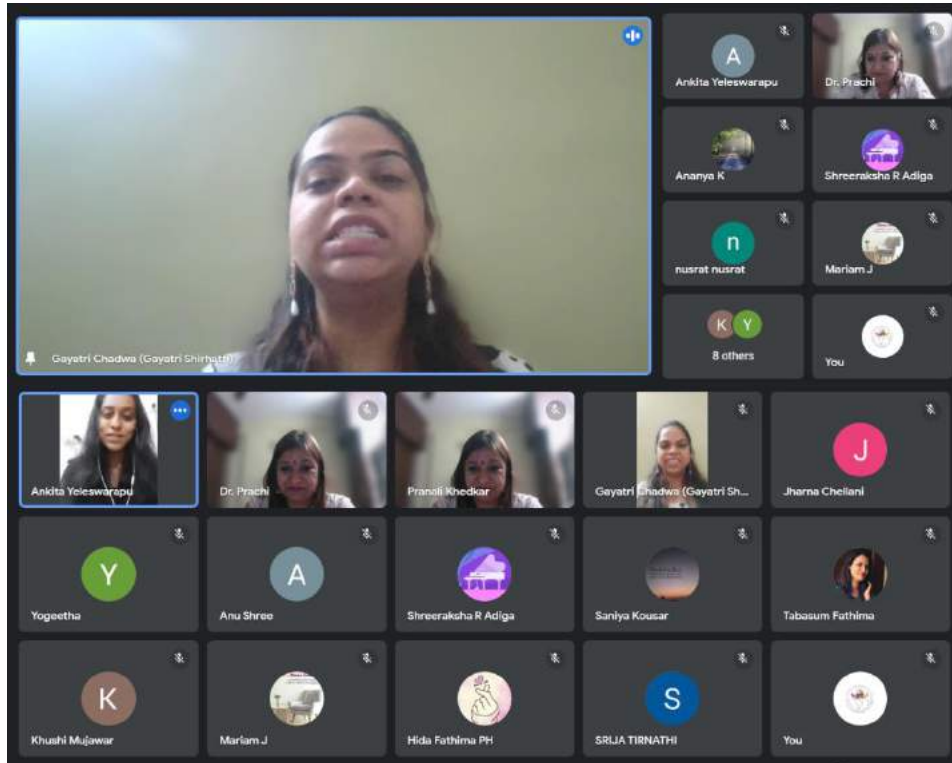

PROTECT YOURSELF -A SELF DEFENCE WORKSHOP

The Martial Arts & Self Defence club was organised a self-defence workshop among Presidency Students on 8th March 2023. The purpose of this workshop is to be able to defend oneself from any and all kinds of attacks, one must be physically fit to do so.

The student participants got different self-protection tips on how to avoid/defend by attacking a potential attacker by using objects or by striking on the soft spots of the attacker, when subjected to physical abuse.

The students were instructed in the following methods.

1.Heel-palm strike: Hitting with an open hand reduces the chance that you'll injure your hand and enables you to more easily attack from a nonconfrontational stance in which you're holding your hands up and open while you set verbal boundaries. Then, if your attacker steps into your comfort zone — bang — he gets it right in the face.

2.Eye strike: The eye strike can be applied while standing or while lying flat. Simply pointing your fingers in your attacker's direction will frequently make him back away. Even if they miss each other, it clears the way for a more lethal blow to be prepared.

3.Knee strike. This method is preferred over all other types of standing kicks because it is simple to perform and can be applied while remaining cantered and near to the ground, which is essential when under the influence of adrenaline. A knee to the groin can put a stop to a brawl right away.
