


3.Sankalp-

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5.Haritvam- Presidency University National Service Scheme had participated in the Green Campus Project, Haritvam in coordination Yuvak sangha with EY Global Ltd. Company and Sparsha Trust for the Environment Literacy Campaign held on 15th December 2022 at Viveka Auditorium, Jayanagar. We were allocated 6 schools and a mentor assigned by the Yuvaka Sangha to each group consisting of 5 volunteers from our college. The Schools were GHPS Vaderahalli, GHPS Manjunath Nagar, GHPS Abbigere, GHPS Bagalgunte, GHPS Agrahara and GHPS Hesarghatta. We started the project with our first visit on 21st January 2023, where each group went to their respective schools and introduced the students about our campaign and the theme that we had to teach them; Water Conservation and Waste Management. The theme was taught to all the students from 6th to 9th standards, about how do we conserve more water, how to manage waste, how to take care of our environment and why is it necessary for everyone. We had told them to make projects related to our campaign and the students came up with very creative projects that were terrarium, piggy bank made from a plastic bottle etc. The campaign was finished within a duration of 2 months with our last visit on 4th March 2023, where we went to the schools and took the feedback of the respective head masters as well as the teachers.
