

- (i) For Sl. No. 1:3: Subject to fulfillment of the conditions that, the University shall appoint 8 faculty in the ratio of 1:2:4 (Professor: Associate Professor: Assistant Professor) for each program, before commencement of the academic year 2018-19, another 8 faculty for the year academic year 2019-20 and another 8 faculty for the academic year 2020-21 in the same ratio for the total 540 intake (1<sup>st</sup> year 180 + 2<sup>nd</sup> year 180 + 3<sup>rd</sup> year 180) with total of 24 faculty as per UGC norms.
- (ii) For Sl. No. 4 to 6 : Subject to fulfillment of the condition that the University shall appoint 6 faculty in the ratio of 1:2:4 (Professor; Associate Professor: Assistant Professor) for each program before commencement of the academic year 2018-19, another 6 faculty for the academic year 2019-20 and another 6 faculty for the academic year 2020-21 in the same ratio for the total 360 intake (1<sup>st</sup> year 120 + 2<sup>nd</sup> year 120 + 3<sup>rd</sup> year 120) with total of 18 faculty as per UGC normas.

### **Preamble:-**

The Registrar, Presidency University, vide his letter read at Sl.No(1) above, submitted the proposal before the State Government seeking permission to offer new courses, to enhance and reduce the intake of existing courses in Presidency University w.e.f A.Y. 2019-20.

Pursuant thereto, inspection of the Presidency University was caused to be made by the Committee comprising of eminent educationists constituted by Karnataka State Higher Education Council. The inspection report submitted by the Karnataka State Higher Education Council vide letter read at Sl.No(2) above, has been duly considered in view of the findings envisaged and recommendations made therein.

Hence the following Order

### **GOVERNMENT ORDER NO:ED 365 URC 2018, Dated:24.01.2019**

In view of the circumstance briefed hereinabove, the Government of Karnataka are pleased to accord permission to the Presidency University for offering New Courses, for enhancement and reduction of intake of Courses existing therein as per the Annexures attached herewith this Order and marked as Annexure-1, Annexure-2 and Annexure-3 respectively, subject to the fulfilment of following conditions

1. The University shall provide required Infrastructure, Faculty (Student Teacher Ratio and Cadres) and other academic facilities (Library, Internet, Laboratories, etc.,) as specified by UGC/AICTE /regulations for maintenance of minimum standards for starting and continuation of the new programs.
2. The nomenclature of degrees and duration of courses shall be as specified in the UGC and AICTE Regulations as notified from time to time.
3. The University shall strictly adhere to the GO issued by the Dept. of Higher Education, GOK vide Notification ED 209 TEC 2018, Dated: 04.12.2018.
