# REPORT On FACUTY INDUCTION PROGRAM

#### A BRIEF REPORT ON TRAINING SESSION

In order to enhance the quality of Academic activities across all the Schools of Presidency University and to focus on the Faculty Members development, Dean-Academics Dr. P.S. Venkataramu conducted second phase training session for Faculty Members of SOL [Commercial Law Group] on Course Hand out preparation complying to OBE". A brief report of this session is furnished below:

This training was focused on facilitating the faculty members in development of Course hand out for a common course collectively incorporating the OBE Concepts. 8 faculty members have participated in the training and the course selected was "Intellectual Property Rights" a core course for the B.A, LLB Program.

Following steps were followed in the session and the course hand out was prepared:

- 1. Familiarization to the job description of the employers.
- 2. Identification of the course in which most of them are familiar for the case study.
- 3. Identification of the job descriptions which can be addressed through the selected course.
- 4. Selection of such job descriptions currently not been able to address due to the limitations of the syllabus.
- 5. Selecting the appropriate level of Blooms' taxonomy to be adopted for the first unit of the course.
- 6. Developing the course outcomes based on the selected Bloom's level, content and the job description.
- 7. Mapping of these course outcomes to the program outcome.
- 8. Setting sample thought provoking questions based on the selected Bloom's level, course outcomes and the competency to be developed based on the job deception of the employer.
- 9. Preparation of the activity for problem based learning.
- 10 Preparation of schedule of instruction for Module -2 and the lesson plan for one lesson.

This training was focused on facilitating the faculty members in development of Course hand out for a common course collectively incorporating the OBE Concepts. 8 faculty members have participated in the training and the course selected was "Marketing Management" a core course for the B Com, BBA Program.

Following steps were followed in the session and the course hand out was prepared:

- 1. Familiarization to the job description of the employers.
- 2. Identification of the course in which most of them are familiar for the case study.
- 3. Identification of the job descriptions which can be addressed through the selected course.
- 4. Selection of such job descriptions currently not been able to address due to the limitations of the syllabus.
- 5. Selecting the appropriate level of Blooms' taxonomy to be adopted for the first unit of the course.
- 6. Developing the course outcomes based on the selected Bloom's level, content and the job description.
- 7. Mapping of these course outcomes to the program outcome.
- 8. Setting sample thought provoking questions based on the selected Bloom's level, course outcomes and the competency to be developed based on the job deception of the employer.
- 9. Preparation of the activity for problem based learning.
- 10 Preparation of schedule of instruction for Module -2 and the lesson plan for one lesson.



## REPORT On

### **Course Handouts (CHOs) Preparation Session**

(On 4<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022 & 8<sup>th</sup> Sep 2022)



An offline review session on **Course handouts (CHOs) preparation** was conducted by respected Dr. Shilpa Mehta, Dean Academics to all the Department / School in presence of all the Department / School faculty members for all the courses mentioned in the forthcoming Fall (Odd) Semester 2022-23. The meeting was commenced by Dean Academics with the following agenda points were discussed and listed below:

## Agenda No 1: Upgrading the Course Outcomes to higher cognitive levels as per Bloom's Taxonomy.

Dean Academics randomly audited the course handouts of all semesters like I, III, V and VII Semesters, suggested all the faculty members to upgrade the bloom's level of the course outcomes of higher semester courses to higher cognitive/Blooms level, wherever feasible and recommended to raise the level of teaching to upgrade the student's cognitive level. She also mentioned the following points:

- To choose the verbs in blooms taxonomy depending on the course content and the course delivery.
- Couse outcomes should be applicable to all the students irrespective of student's attainment level in the exams.

#### Agenda No 2: Raise the level of teaching to analysis level wherever feasible

Dean Academics suggested all the faculty members to raise the level of teaching to analysis level especially in higher semesters so as to improve the employability ratio of the students.

#### Agenda No 3: Proper assignment of Course codes

Dean Academics conveyed that for the same type of course, the course code can be different as the course code represents a unique number. For eg. Digital electronics course can be taught to branches like Computer science Engineering, Electronics and communication Engineering and Electrical & Electronics Engineering with different course content but different course codes.

#### Agenda No 4: Verifying the PRC Reference number, Semester, Year

Dean Academics instructed all the faculty members to verify the PRC Reference number, Semester, Year properly in all the course handouts and update if any changes are required. She mentioned a uniform numbering scheme for PRC documents

#### Other discussion points:

- 1. The Library link in the CHO and Catalogues should be given from Nimbus Link.
- 2. The concept of writing Thought provoking questions and more number of questions should be added in the question papers.
- 3. Writing of Course outcomes, mapping it with Programme outcomes was discussed with relevant examples.



### A BRIEF REPORT ON WORK SHOP ON C.O. & P.O. ATTAINMENT COMPUTATIONS

A detailed presentation on C.O. and P.O attainment commutations was presented by the Dean-Academics & Prof. Sudheendra to all the HODs and a few professors of the SOE along with the Dean-SOE and COE. The list of members present in the work shop is attached with the report.

#### **Points Explained:**

01. All the faculty members have to enter the Course Outcomes in the Edhitch Platform for their respective

courses.

- 02. P.O.s for all the departments will be entered by Prof. Sudheendra. [this arrangement is only for this semester, next semester onwards the respective HODs have to enter this.]
- 03. The faculty members have to go to "Course Outcome" menu and click "Calculate C.O." then click "Add new"
- 04 In the open window, please enter the following in the respective box:
  - a. Type of Input: "External Exams marks already imported" [ this means the test external to edhitch, i.e. it is conducted off line.]
  - b. Select Input: Type TEST 1
  - c. Select Course Code: Click the concerned C.Os used for the test along with the weightage of marks for each C.O. in percentage. [Example: C.O 01, C.O. 02 with a weightage of 70% for C.O.01& 30% weightage for C.O.02 I.E. out of total of 40 marks 28 marks questions for C.O. 01 and 12 marks for C.O.02 in the question paper]
  - d. Bloom's Level: Neglect this [No entry]

- e. Delivery Method: Lecture method
- f. Select P.O.s: From the mapping table of your course hand out type all the P.O.s mapped for the above

selected C.O.s [Ex. P.O 01, P.O 03, P.O. 05 & so on]

- g. Total marks: enter test 1 marks [EX. 40]
- h. Weightage: Enter 20 % [refer the concerned P.R.C.]
- i. Set Rules:

Attainment Level 01: Percentage of students: 80% Grade in the Scale of: 16

Attainment Level 02: Percentage of students: 55% Grade in the Scale of: 20

Attainment Level 03: Percentage of students: 20% Grade in the Scale of: 28

- 05 After all the entry from a to i Click the POST button at the left corner bottom of the page.
- 06 Go to main Menu and click on "Assignment".
- 07 Select and click on "Off line Exam"
- 08 Go to the "Add off line Exam" at the right side corner on top of the sheet.
- 09 Enter the following data in that page:
  - a. Type of input: Select "Internal Exam"
  - b. Exam Topic: Type "TEST 1"
  - c. Total Marks: Enter "40" Weight: 20%
  - d. Enter all the students' marks or import the file.
  - e. Click "SUBMIT" button at the left bottom corner of the page.
- 10. Go to "course outcome "Menu and click on "calculate you get CO attainment table save/take print out of the same.
- 11. Again go to "course outcome "Menu and click on "CO-PO Maping" you get PO attainment table save

take print out of the same.

#### 12. The Computation Methodology is as follows:

C.O ATTAINMENT: The software computes the attainment level based on the marks entry of students and the rule setting. It checks for the attainment of any level out of 3 levels defined and select such level in which your actual attainment is more than the set attainment. [EX. Rule set is Attainment level 01 is 80 % of students scoring G.T. 16 /40 marks, Attainment level 02 is 55% of the students scoring. G.T.20/40 Marks and Attainment Level 03 is 20 % of the students scoring G.T. 28/40 marks. And the achievement based on the students' marks entry is: % age students scoring level 01 is 82%, % age students scoring level 2 is 62% and the %ge students scoring level 3 is 12%, THEN THE CO ATTAINMENT ACHIEVED IS LEVEL 02.

Like this the software computes the attainment level for all the outcomes and computes the "Average C.O. attainment level"

#### **P.O ATTAINMENT:**

Based on the mapping and the level of mapping [i.e. H, M.L the software prepares the table by giving a number of 01, 02, 03 & 0.0 based on L.M.H NOT MAPPED for each of the P.O. and the attainment value of C.O. for that P.O. [sum of all the numbers from 1 to 3 divided by the number of C.O. s mapped for that P.O.]

The P.O. Attainment =

Average C.O. attainment for that P.O [as computed in the above table] \*Average C.O. Attainment [computed in the previous computation] / Total Number of Levels [in this case it is fixed as 3]

The above methodology was explained to all the members and all their doubts were cleared with examples in the session. Some of the HODs expressed that this session needs to be given to all the faculty members and the Dean-Academics has suggested HODs to fix up the schedule department wise and the sessions will be conducted.




Understanding Higher Education in India by Dr. Narayana Swamy (External, Presidency College) -




#### TEACHING ENGINEERING AND MAXIMIZE LEARNING THROUGH BLENDED APPROACHES BY DR. JAGDISH




#### Mon, 22 July, 2019






### Ph.D. Scope in Presidency University and Interdisciplinary Research by Dr. Ramesh, Dean Research – (1.30 to 3.00 pm)


In this session, various opportunities and challenges faced by students and the placement team was outlined. The importance of training the students to equip themselves for placement needs was also discussed.
