

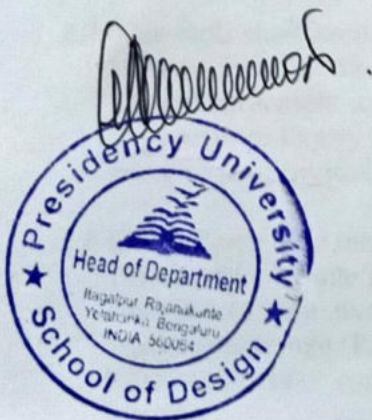

- 1.2.6 Student visits, short-term hands-on workshops and engagements.

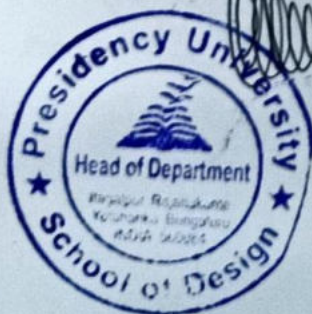
1.3 The extent of collaboration and its implementation under this MoU shall be determined and regulated by availability of resources at both the ends.

Termination by one party shall be affected by giving the other party at least 30-days of advance written notice of its intention to terminate. Students who are undergoing Student-exchange Program at the respective Host Institution as at the date of termination may complete their course of study. Such Termination shall be without penalty.
