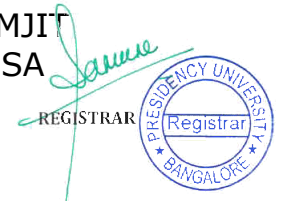

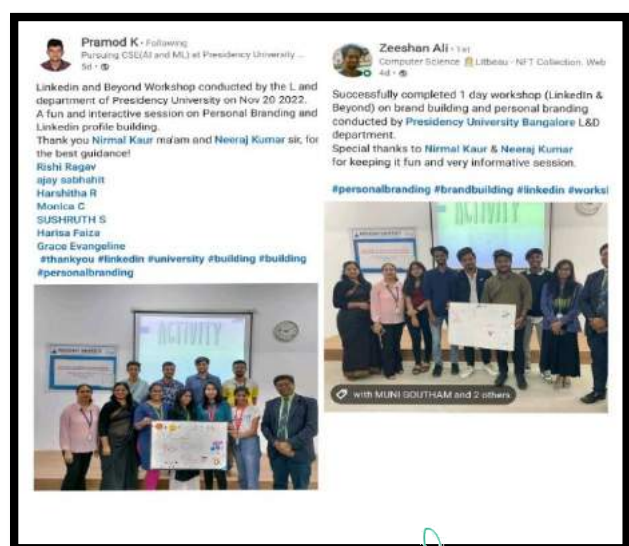
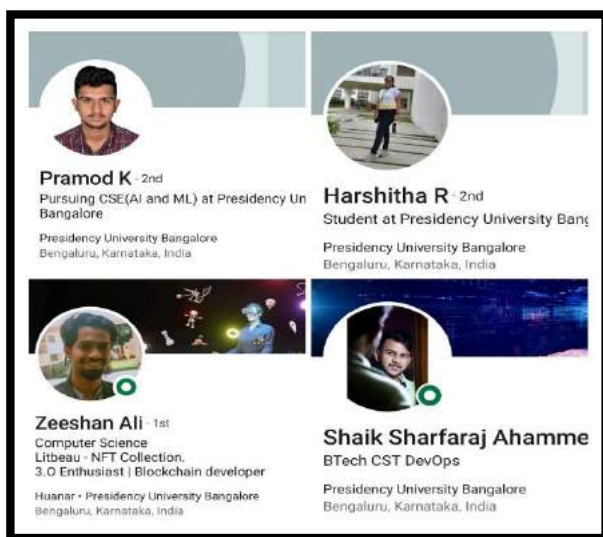
Session 2: Presentation & Hands-on
